

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION  
OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP  
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 29 PARISH OF WORTHEN WITH  
SHELVE)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

On 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2023, The Shropshire Council (the “Council”) confirmed the above named order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to **divert**

the full width of Footpath 29 leaving the Hemford to Hope Park Road at Point A on the Order Map at grid reference SO 3307 0099 running in a general south easterly then ESE direction through the property and over a pasture field to exit onto the Bentlawnt to Gravels Road at point B on the Order Map at grid reference SO 3316 0085. A total distance of approximately 107 metres **onto a line** from a stile on the Hemford to Hope Park Road at point C on the Order Map, grid reference SO 3316 0104 running in a general ESE direction on a natural surface to a stile on the Bentlawnt to Gravels Road at point D on the Order Map at grid reference SO 3321 0102. A total distance of approximately 57 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2023 make an application to the High Court.
