

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 5 (PART), PARISH OF
ABDON & HEATH) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2023**

On 15th February 2024, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above-named order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53 A (2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to **extinguish**; part of Footpath 5 from Point A on the Order Map grid reference SO 5733 8845 travelling in a southerly direction then south-easterly direction across an orchard to Point B on the Order Map grid reference SO 5739 8835. The route to be extinguished is a distance of approximately 146 metres.

The order comes into force on 19th January 2024; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 15th February 2024 make an application to the High Court.
