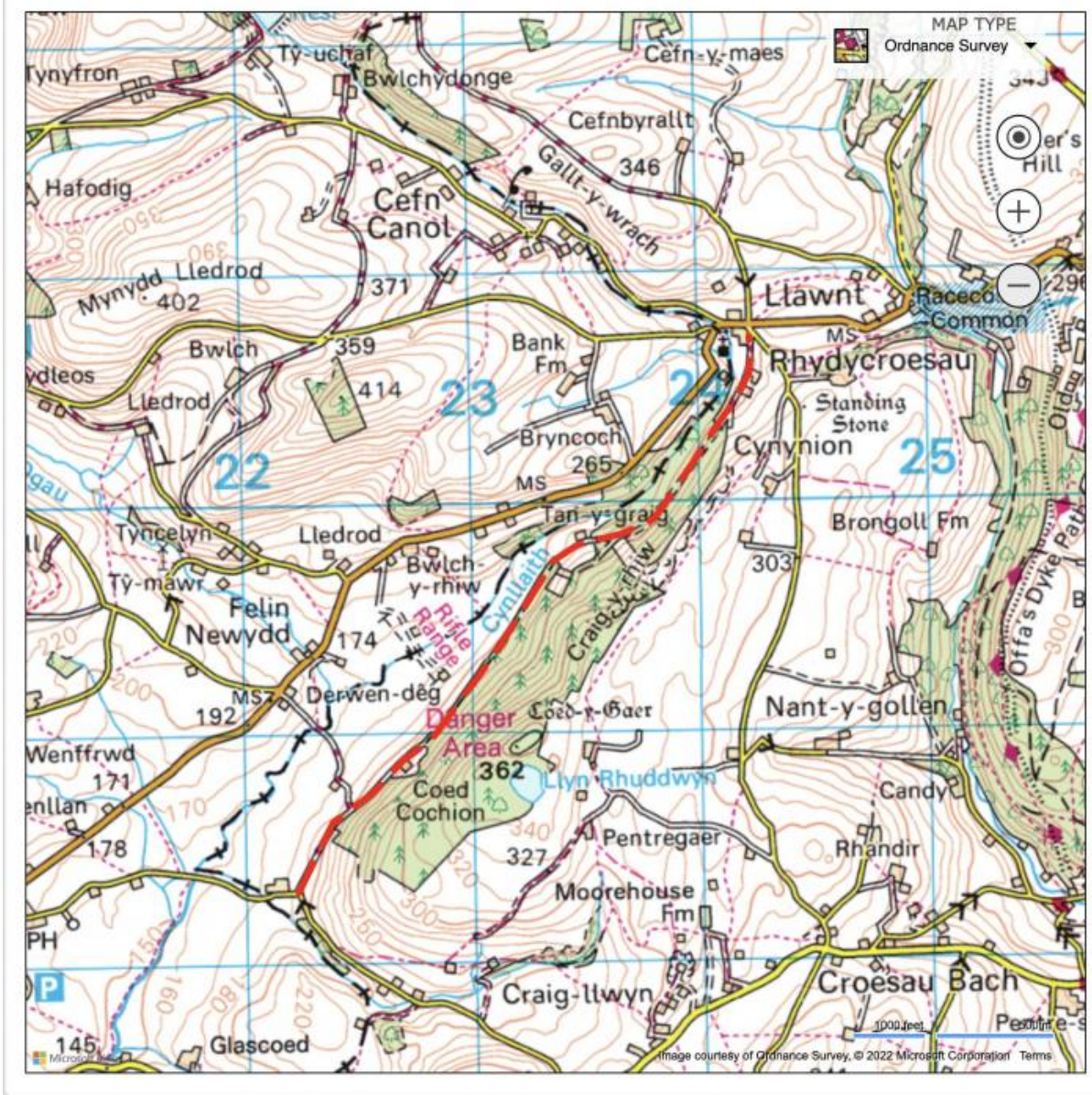

## **Application Details**

## Description of Path:

Path starts at sharp bend in public road near Tan-y-coed SJ2222831 and ends at minor public road just south of Rhydycroesau SJ24233071

From the Rhydycroesau end the unclassified road is metalled until it reaches Tan-y-graig. From here the claimed route runs between mature hedge lines and soon follows the outer edge of woodland which is growing on a steep incline. The way is easier to follow where over hanging branches shade the route so preventing excessive vegetative growth. Fencing on the inside of the woodland edge has greatly reduced the useable width. A wicket gate at the beginning of the Ministry of Defence property has recently been railed across. However there is no accompanying feneline to prevent access. On reaching the property of Coed Cottage newly erected barbed gates stop further progress. These have recently been erected at either end of Coed Cottage property. After this obstruction the claimed route continues as a metalled unclassified road which joins the county road near Llansilin.

# **Documentary Evidence**

## **Evidence from Maps:**

**OS One Inch Ordnance Survey Maps - One-inch England and Wales**

Unrecorded route in the early maps is shown as an unmetalled road, unfenced in places. The latest map shows the unfenced sections as a path or track.

### **Ordnance Survey Maps - 25 inch England and Wales**

Gives areas for parts of the unrecorded route.

### **Bartholomew's Half Inch to the Mile Maps of England and Wales**

Depicted as an inferior road, not recommended to cyclists in 1902. In 1941 it is recorded as other roads rather than a footpath or bridlepath. This map was produced for sale to the travelling and cycling public, and the roads were revised by the Cyclists' Touring Club. The application route was shown as an inferior road rather than a footpath or bridleway. Cyclists in 1903 had no right to use bridleways. Bicycles were classed as carriages by s.85 Local Government Act 1888. A little weight should be given to this document as evidence of vehicular status.

## **Primary Evidence:**

### **Inland Revenue Valuation Records - Finance (1908-10) Act 1910**

Both the north and south sections are excluded from valuation.

### **Tithe Records**

The Tithe Map for this area was drawn up in 1838, thirty years after it had been Inclosed. The route is represented in the same manner as other roads which are recognised as public roads today. A nearby road marked as 89b is a restricted byway today. The route is clearly defined passing two properties which both have small entrances to the route. The claimed route is separate from the properties and is not depicted as belonging to them.

### **Inclosure Records**

Inclosure Award 1808. In the Township of Pentregaer Public Carriage Road A runs through the modern plantation from Tan-y-graig SW to Tan-y-coed y-gaer (now Coed Cottage), linking two existing ORPAs. Carriage road A is shown enclosed by two solid lines passing and separated from both properties ORPA from Rhydycroesau SW through plantation, is shown here as Public Carriage Road D.

### **Handover Maps 1929 Act**

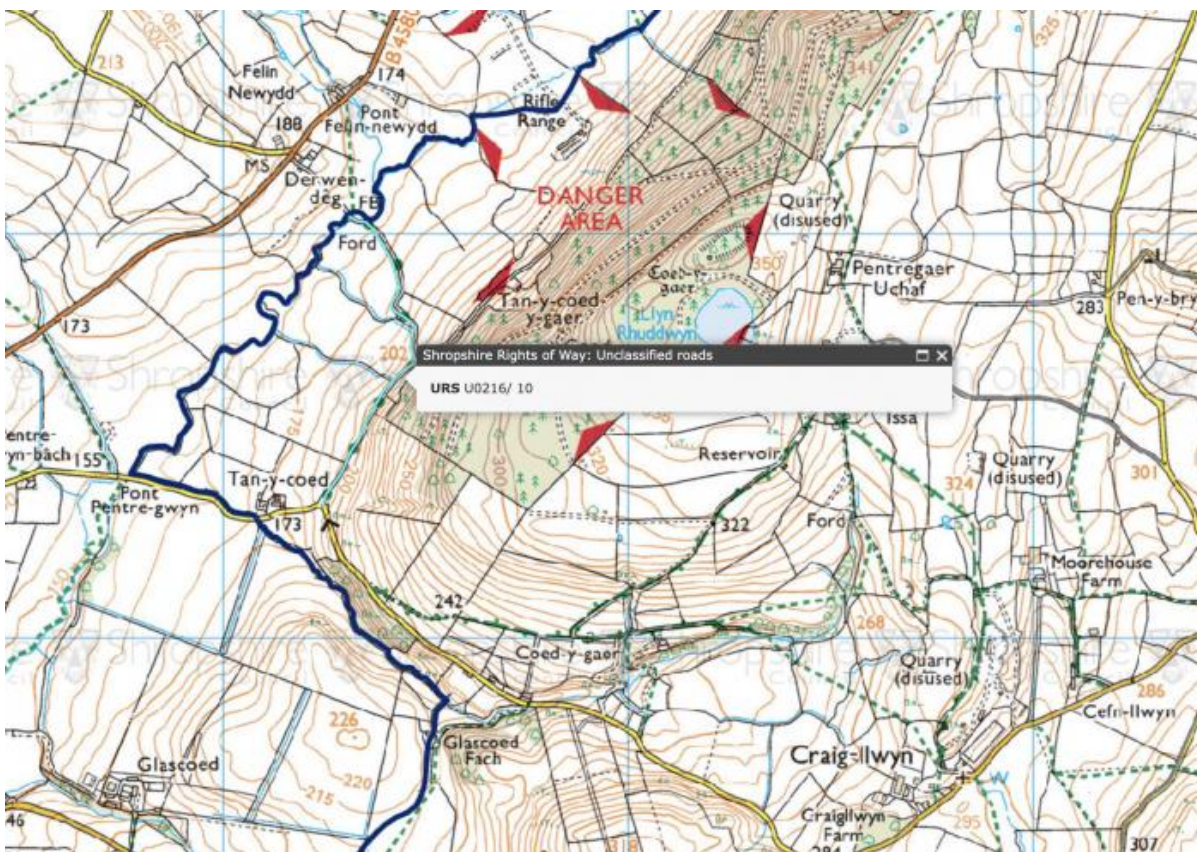


The Local Government Act caused county councils to take over highway responsibilities from the rural district councils on 1st April 1930. Information was supplied by the rural district on maps known as handover maps. The showing of a route on a handover map is good evidence that it existed as a highway maintainable at the public expense. In 1929 the public highway extended further north than the unclassified county road URS U0216/10.

## Other Evidence:

### Rail and Canal Records

The unrecorded route is shown as a public highway by the Vyrnwy Aquaduct in 1880 and a bridleway by the Liverpool Corporation Water works in 1919. It is recorded as being under the Oswestry District Highway Board in 1880 and the Oswestry District Council in 1919.

### Further Evidence

Looking back in 2022 the claimed route is 214 years old. During this time deposition of material has accumulated upon its surface masking its original appearance. Evidence of a retaining wall can be seen in places on the left hand side when travelling south from Tan-y-graig.

## Summary and Statement of Reasons:

When the Townships of Pentregaer and Cyncynion were inclosed in 1808 the claimed route including both sections of unclassified road at either end were made as a 30 foot wide public carriage road. In 1880 the deposited plans for the Vyrnwy Aquaduct showed the pipeline in the vicinity and crossing the claimed route. This was then referred to as a public highway owned by the Oswestry Highway Board. In 1919 the Liverpool Corporation Water Works (DP 660) referred to the claimed route as a bridle road owned by the Oswestry Rural Parish Council.

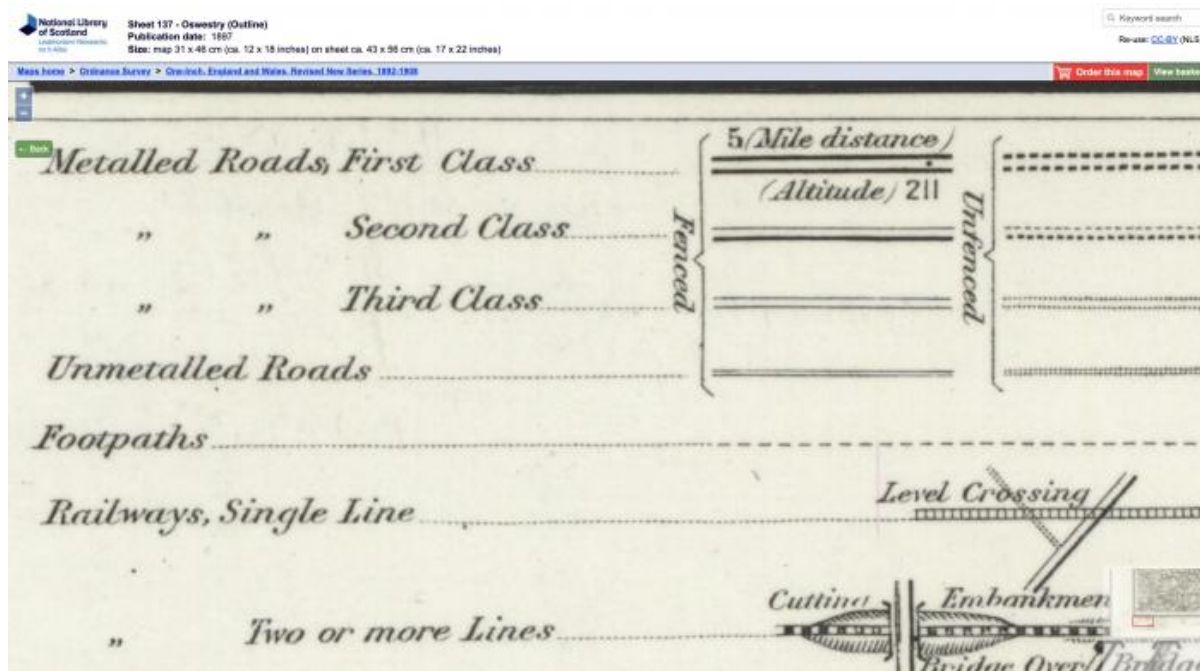

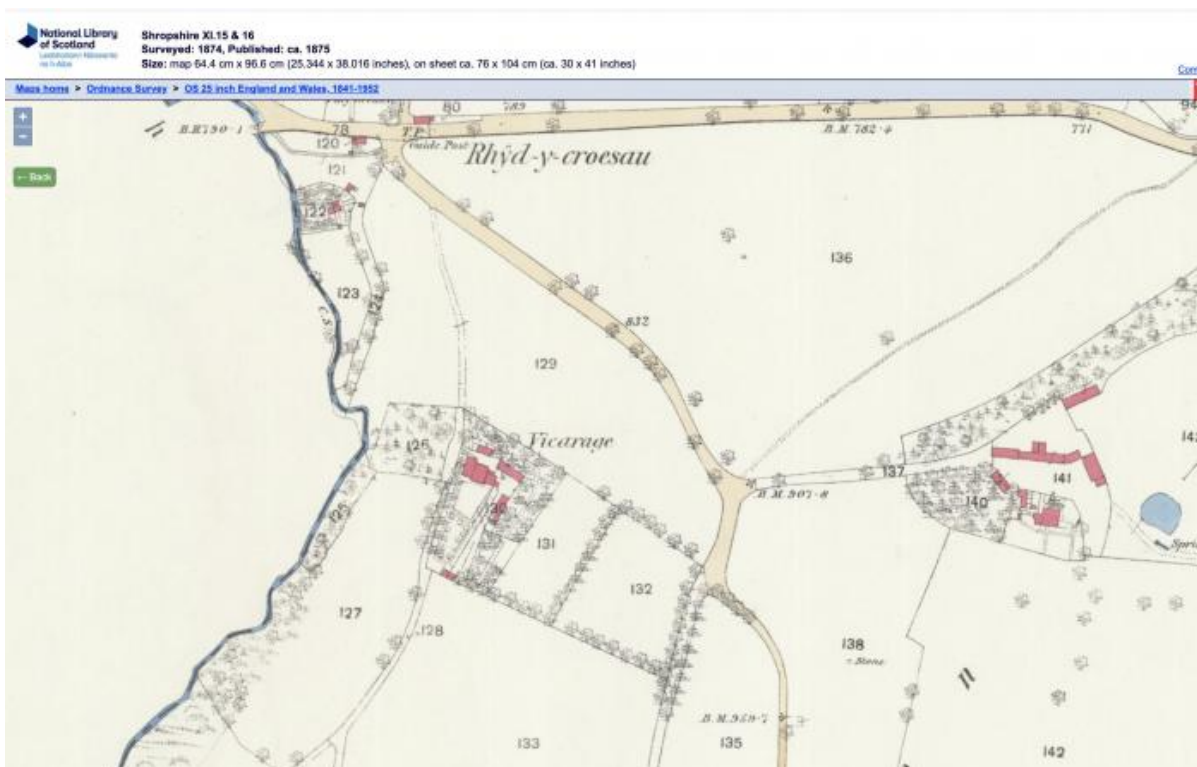

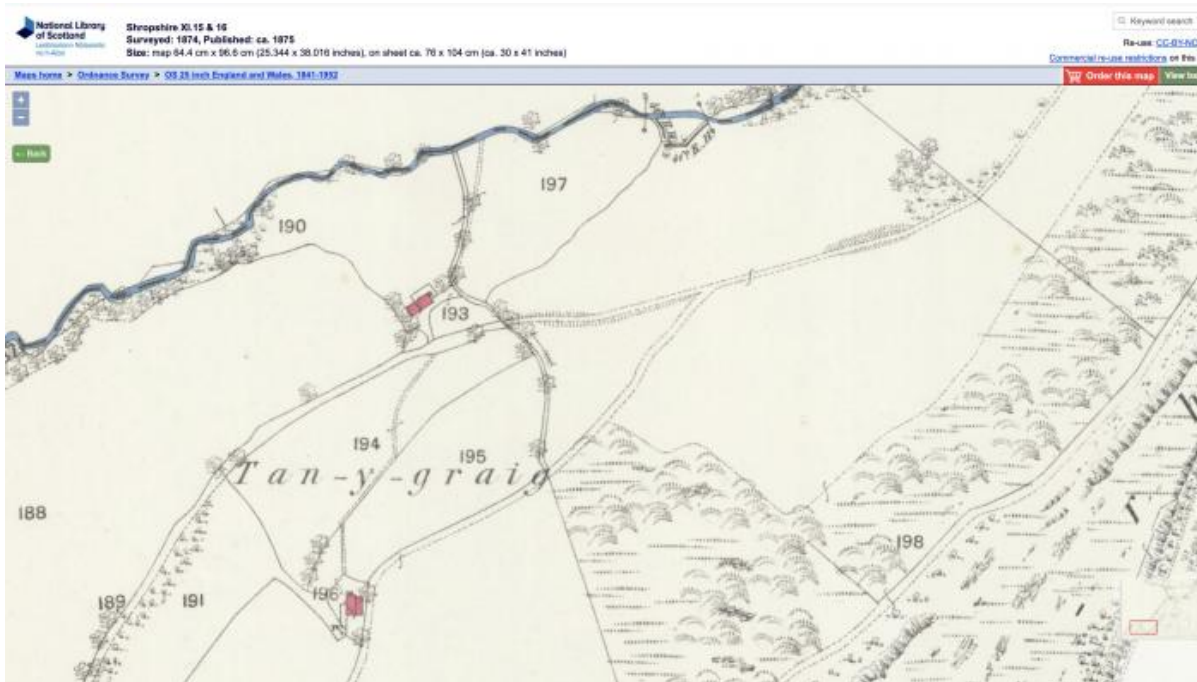

Close up. Unrecorded route is numbered 128



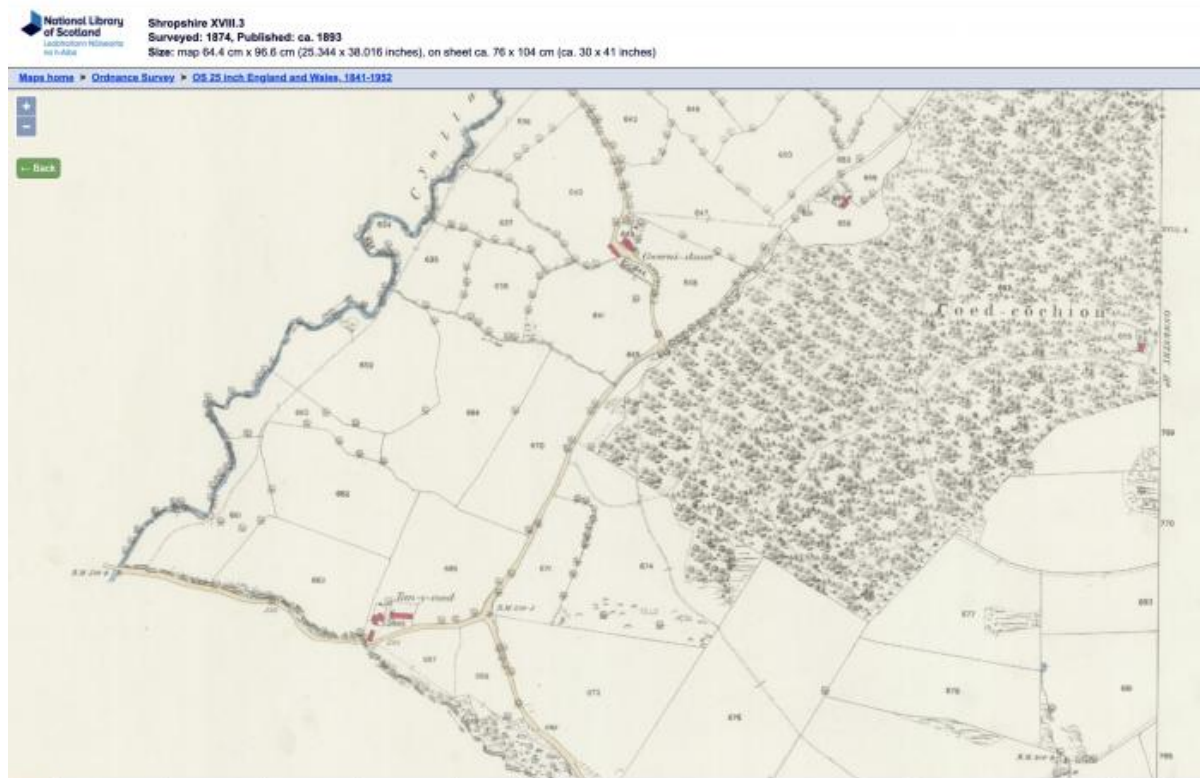

Close up of Tan-y-graig route below is numbered 189



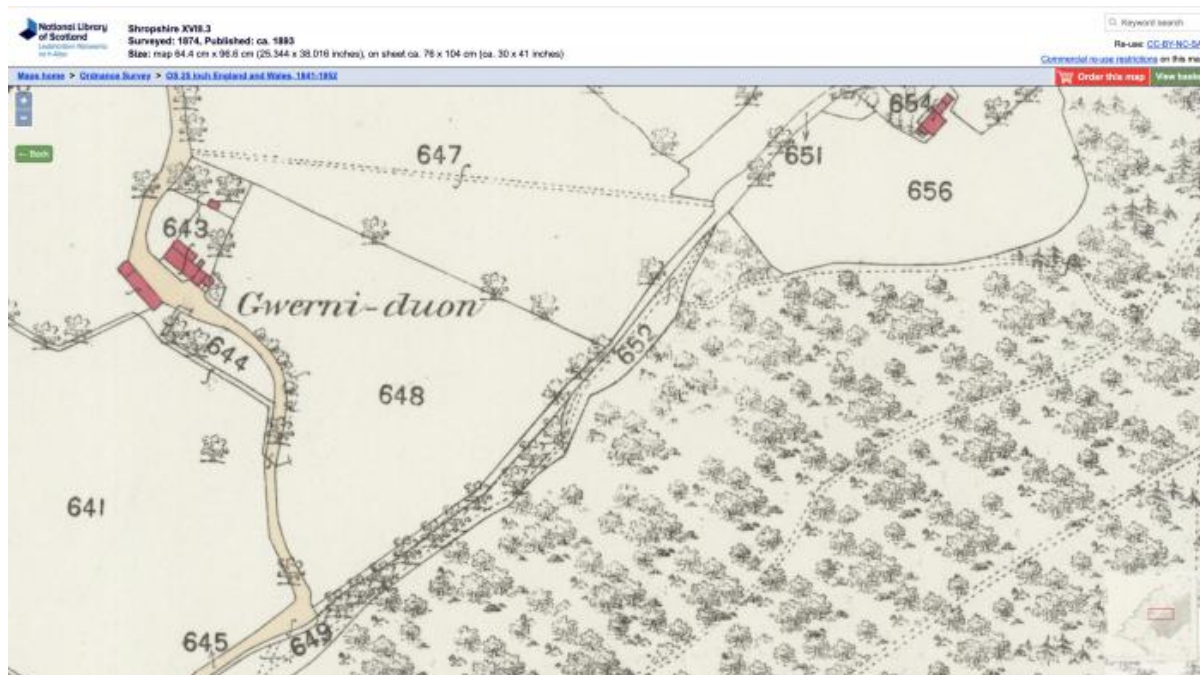

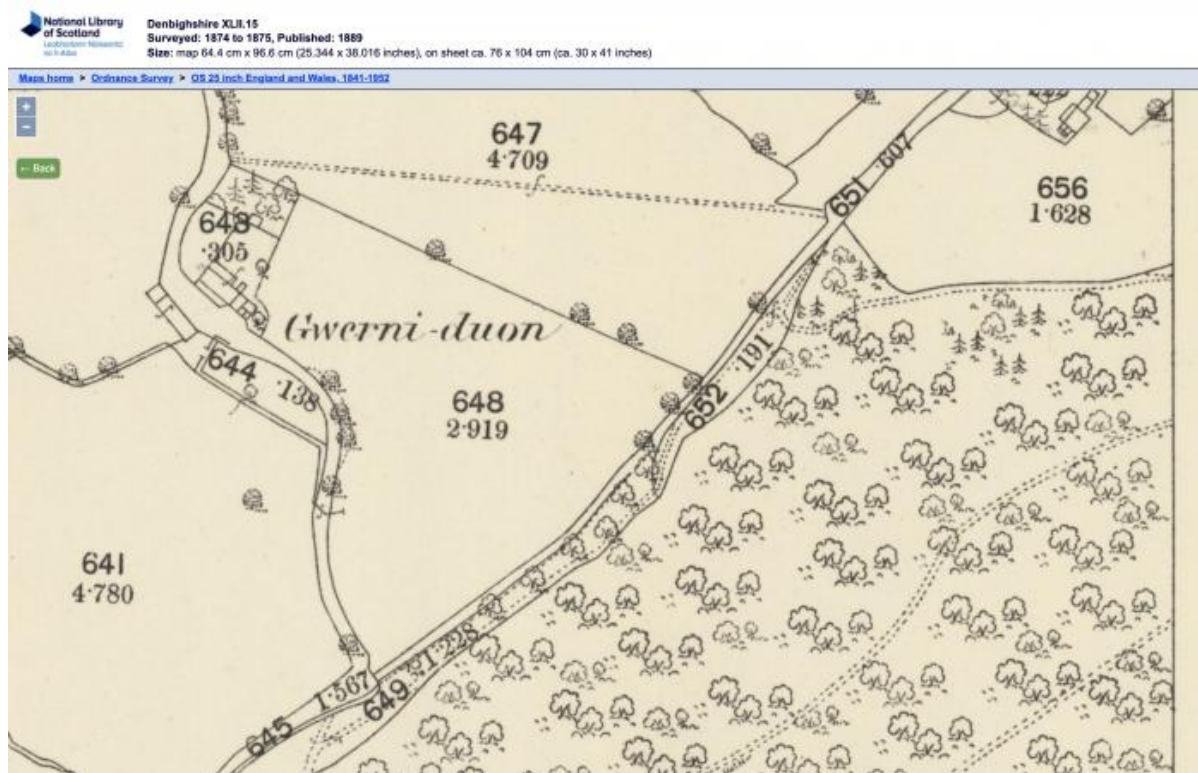

Enlarged view. Today's unclassified county road is numbered 645, the claimed route is 651



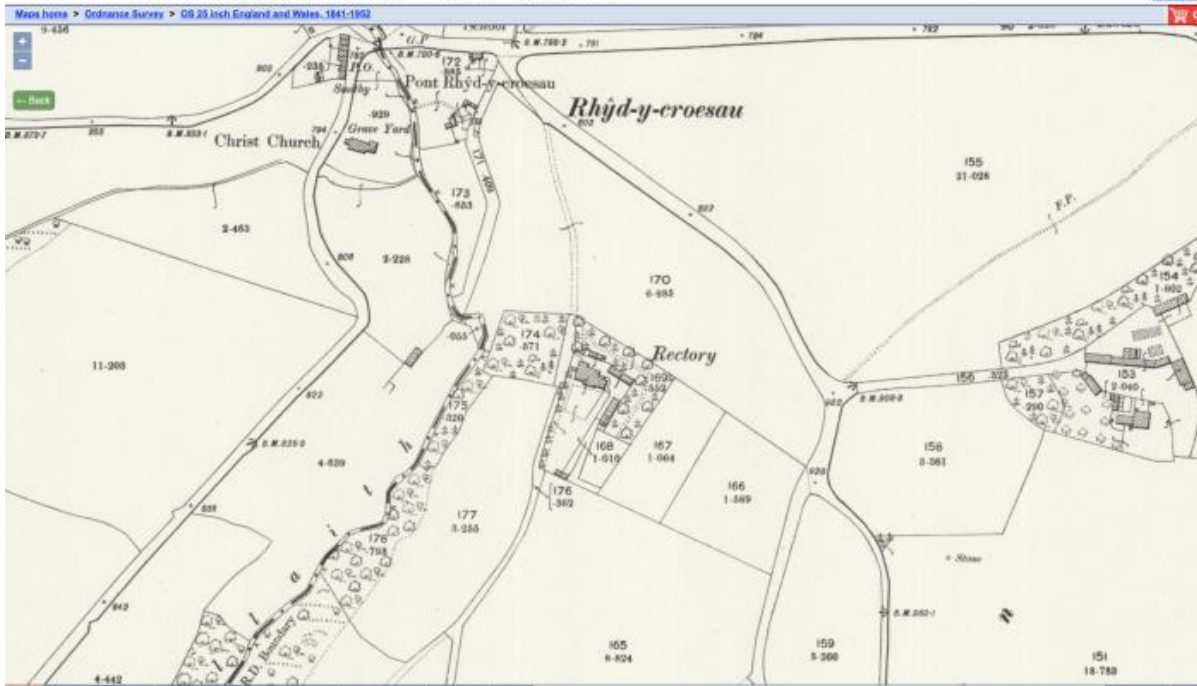

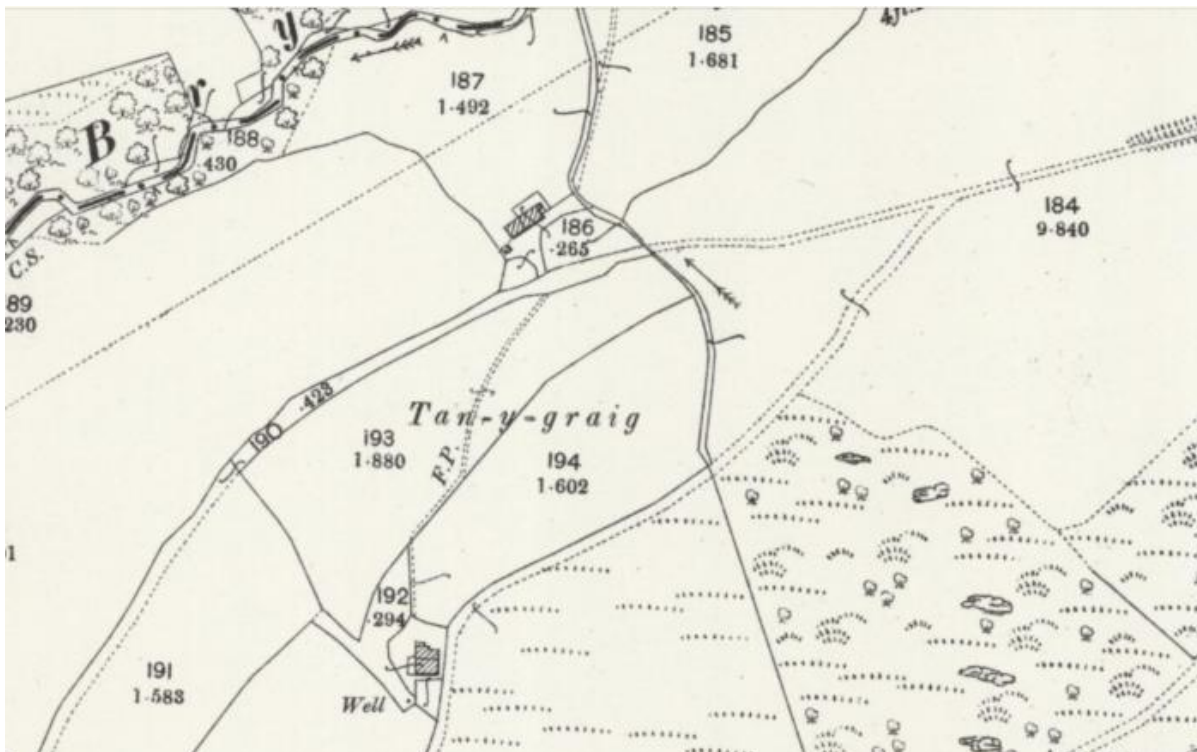

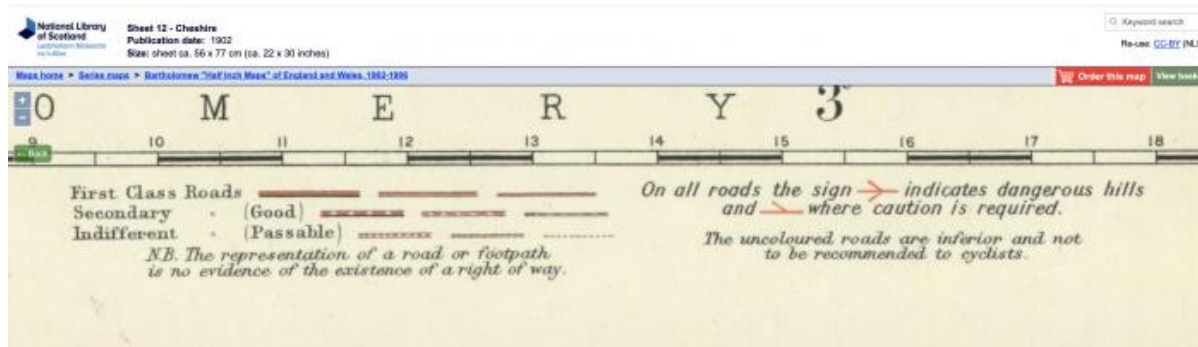

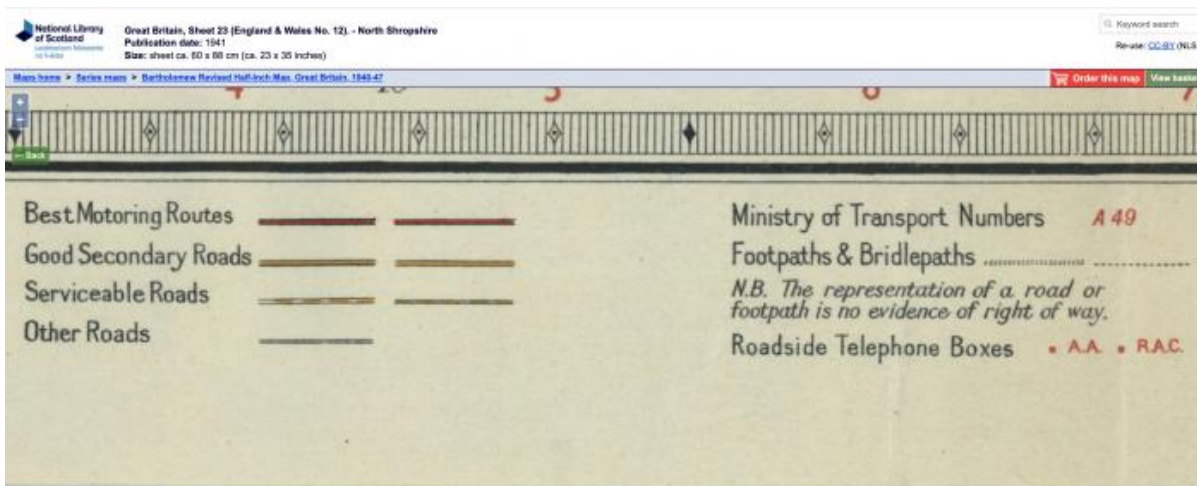
Bartholomew Half Inch, Sheet 23 North Shropshire, 1941

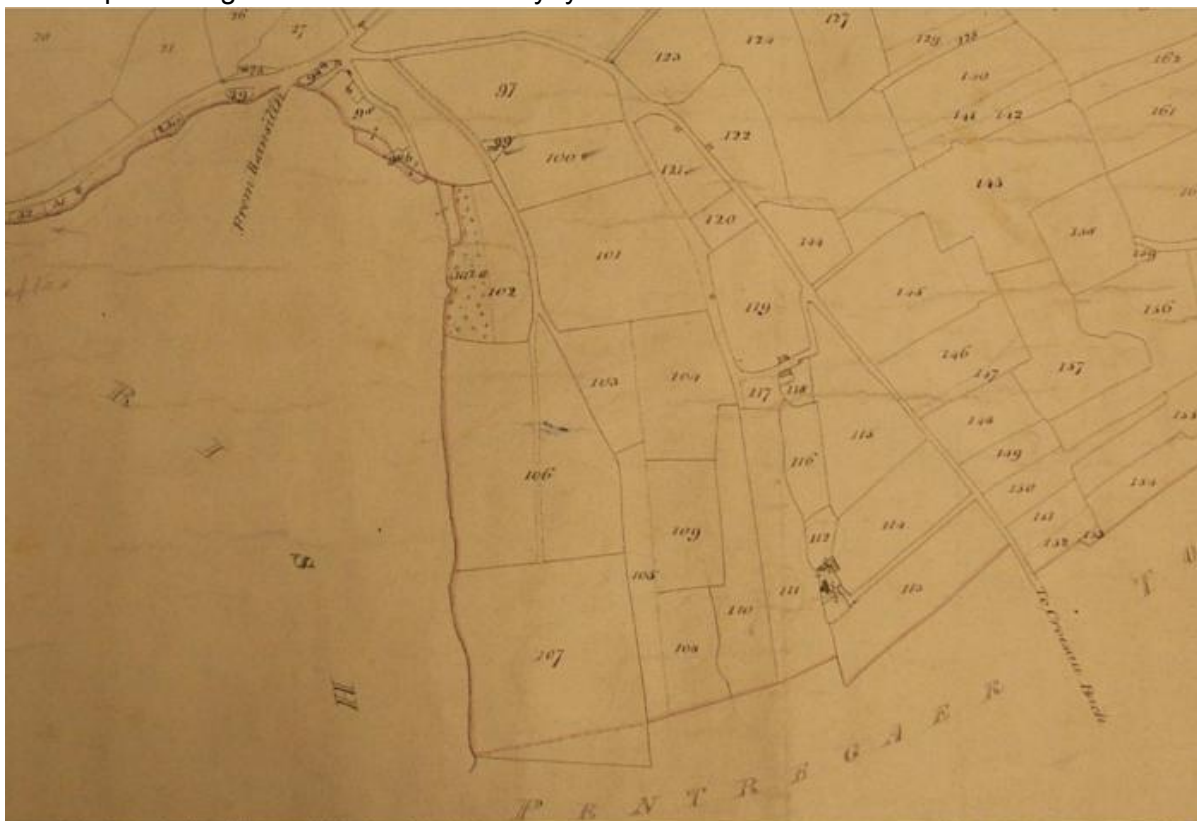

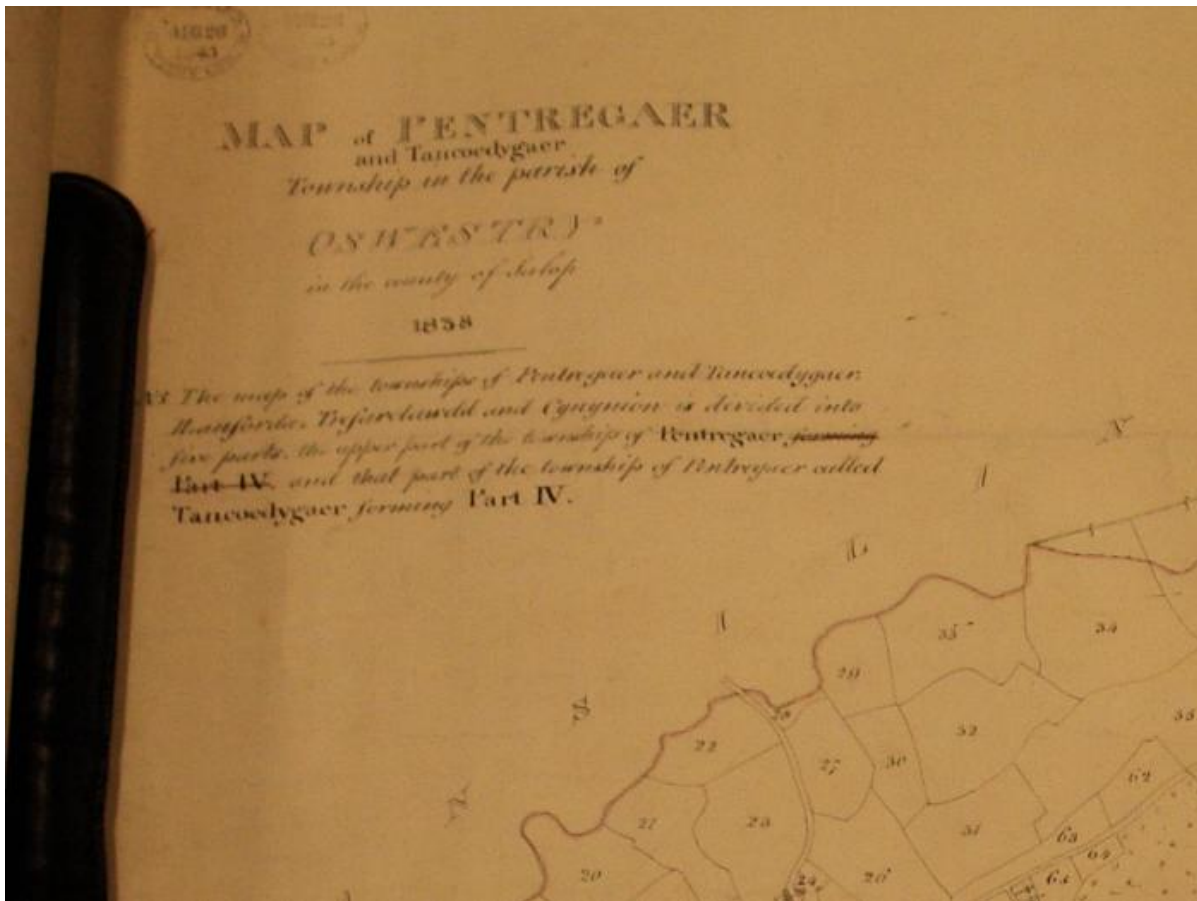

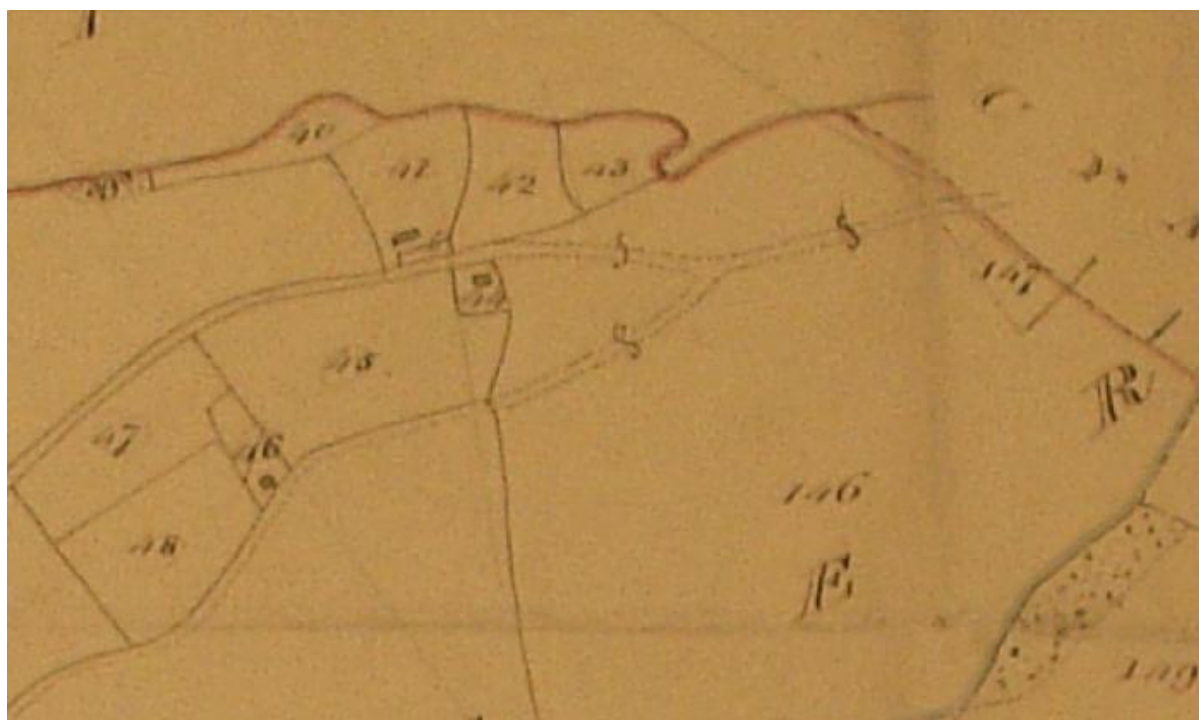
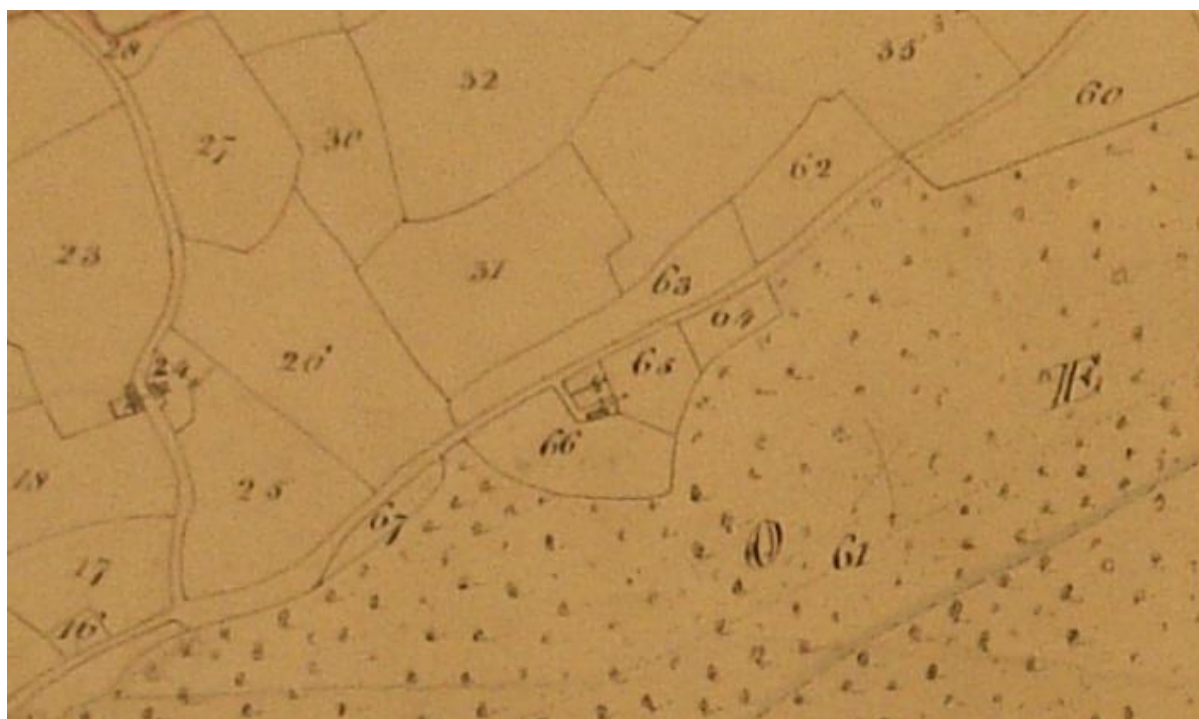


Tithe Map of Pentregaer Township, IR 30 29 199, 1838

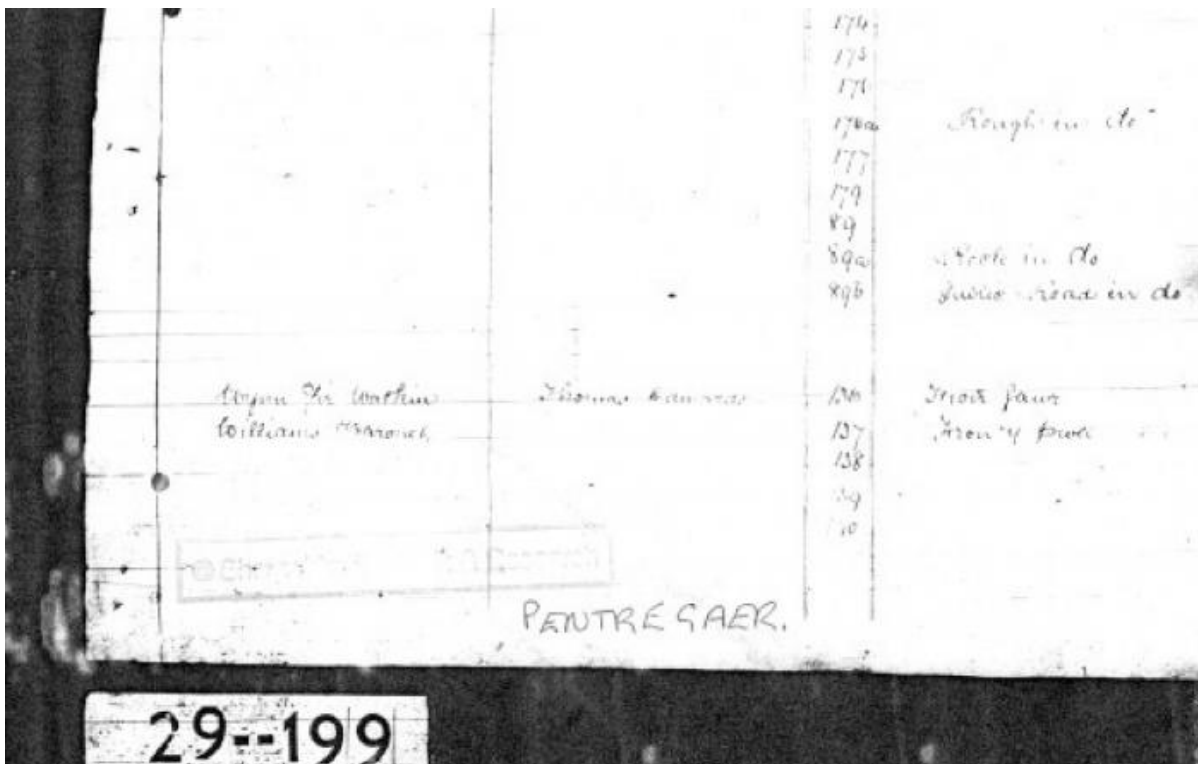

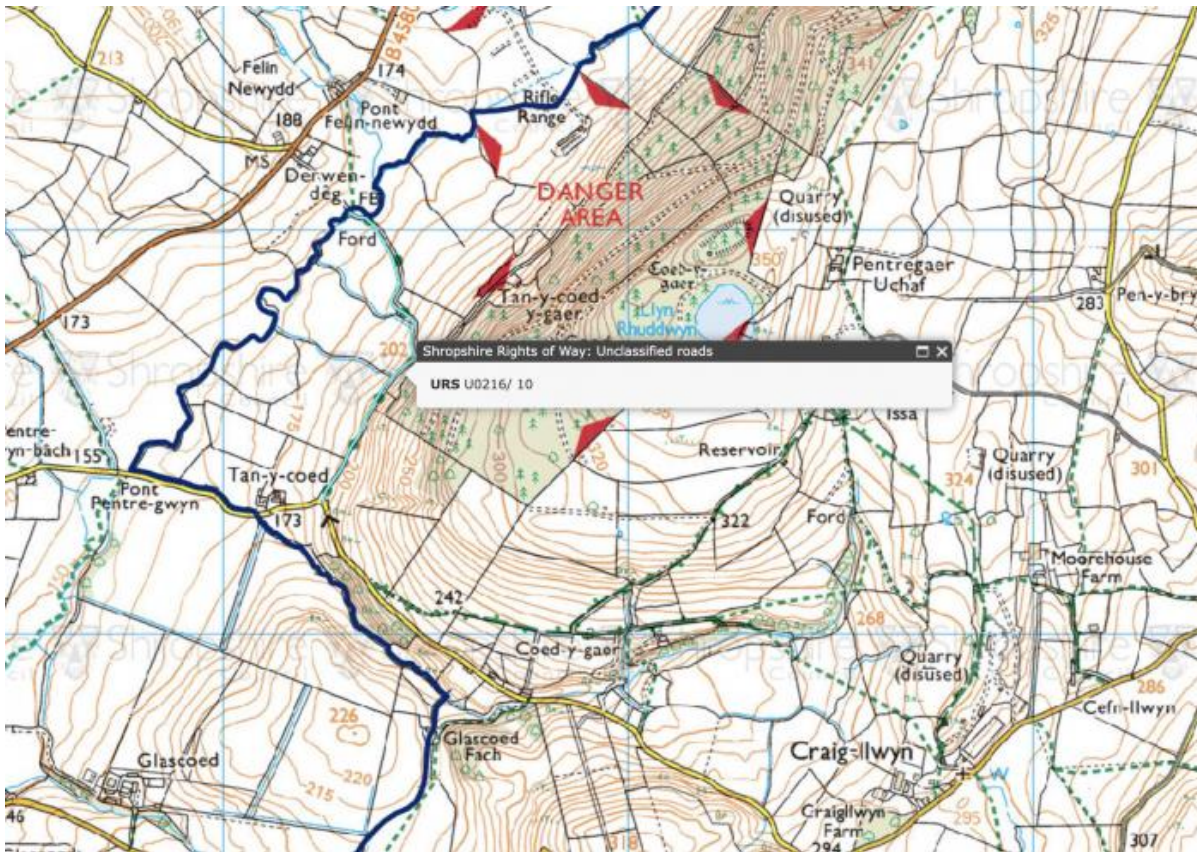

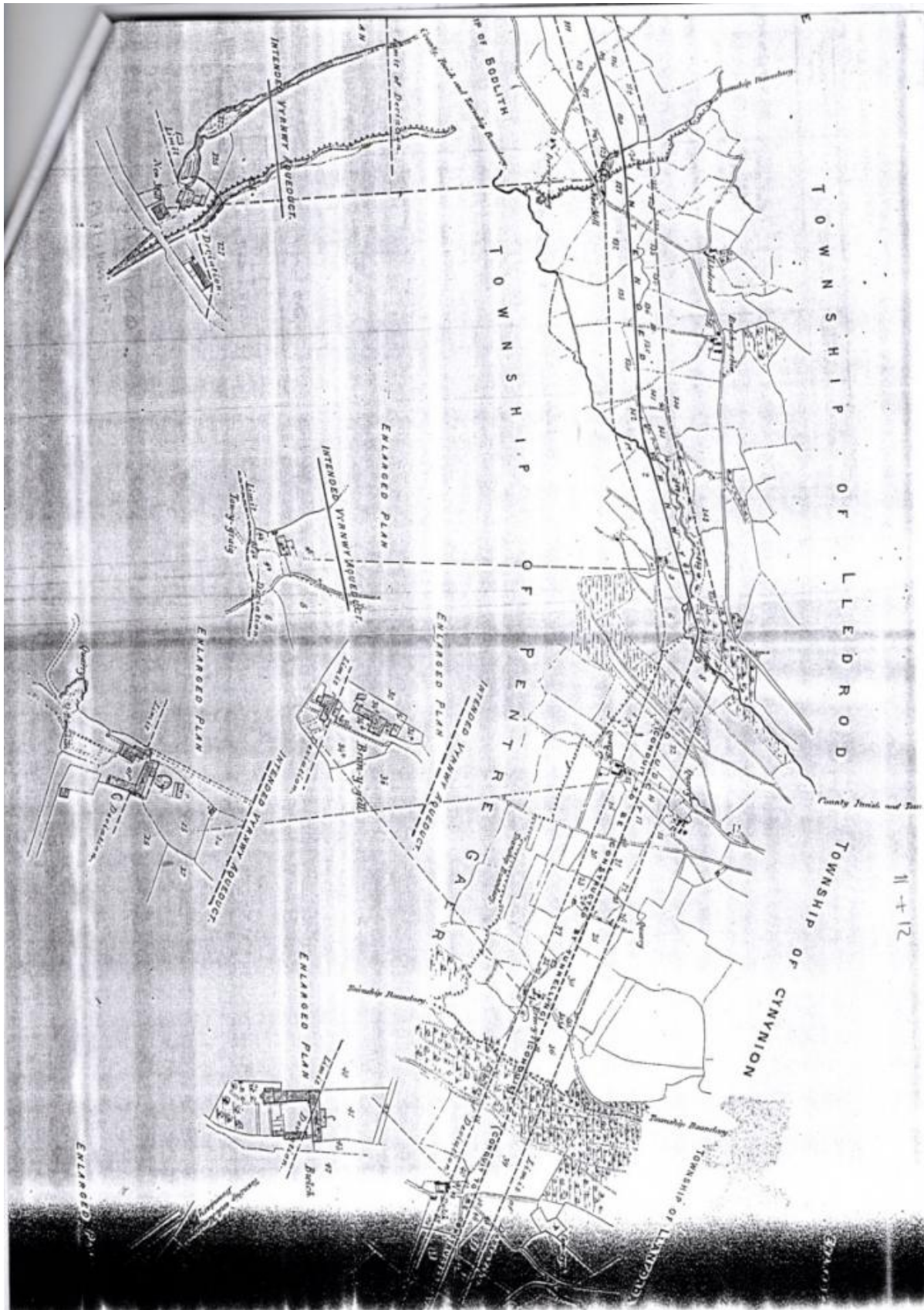

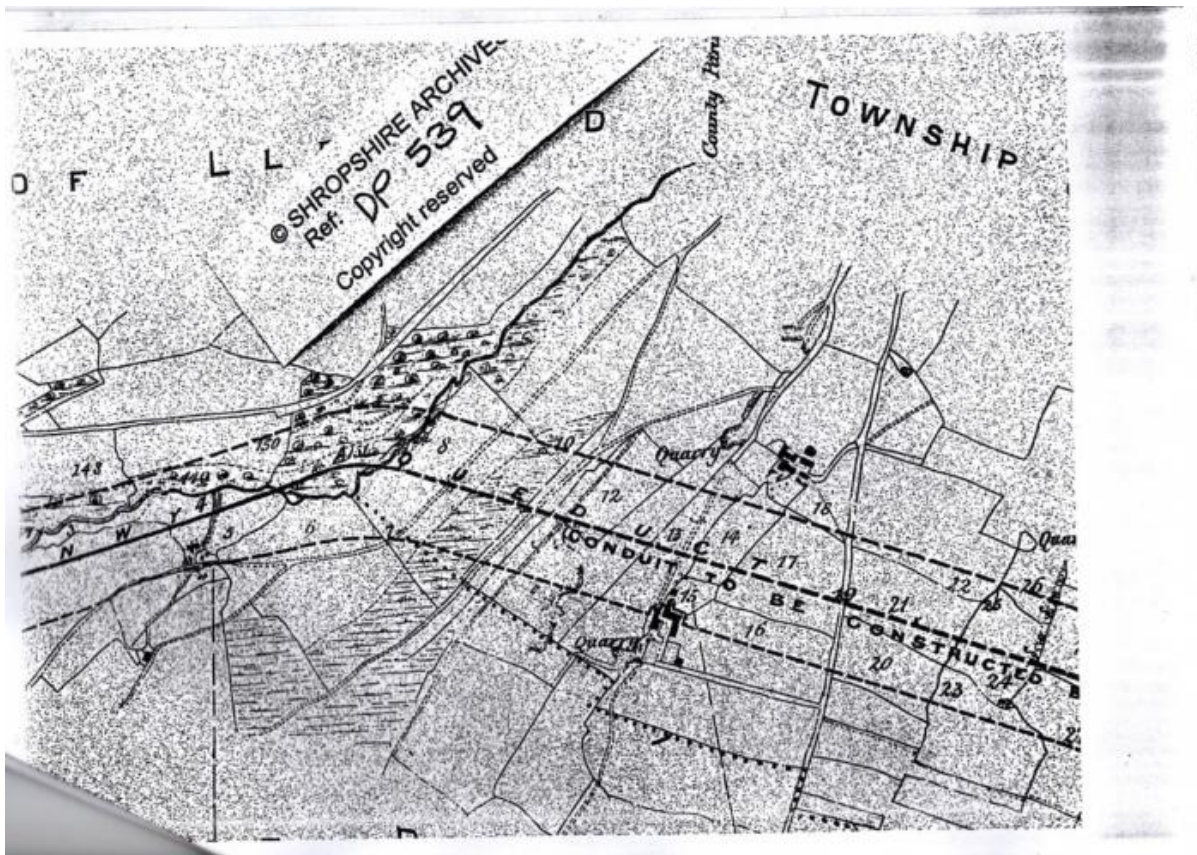

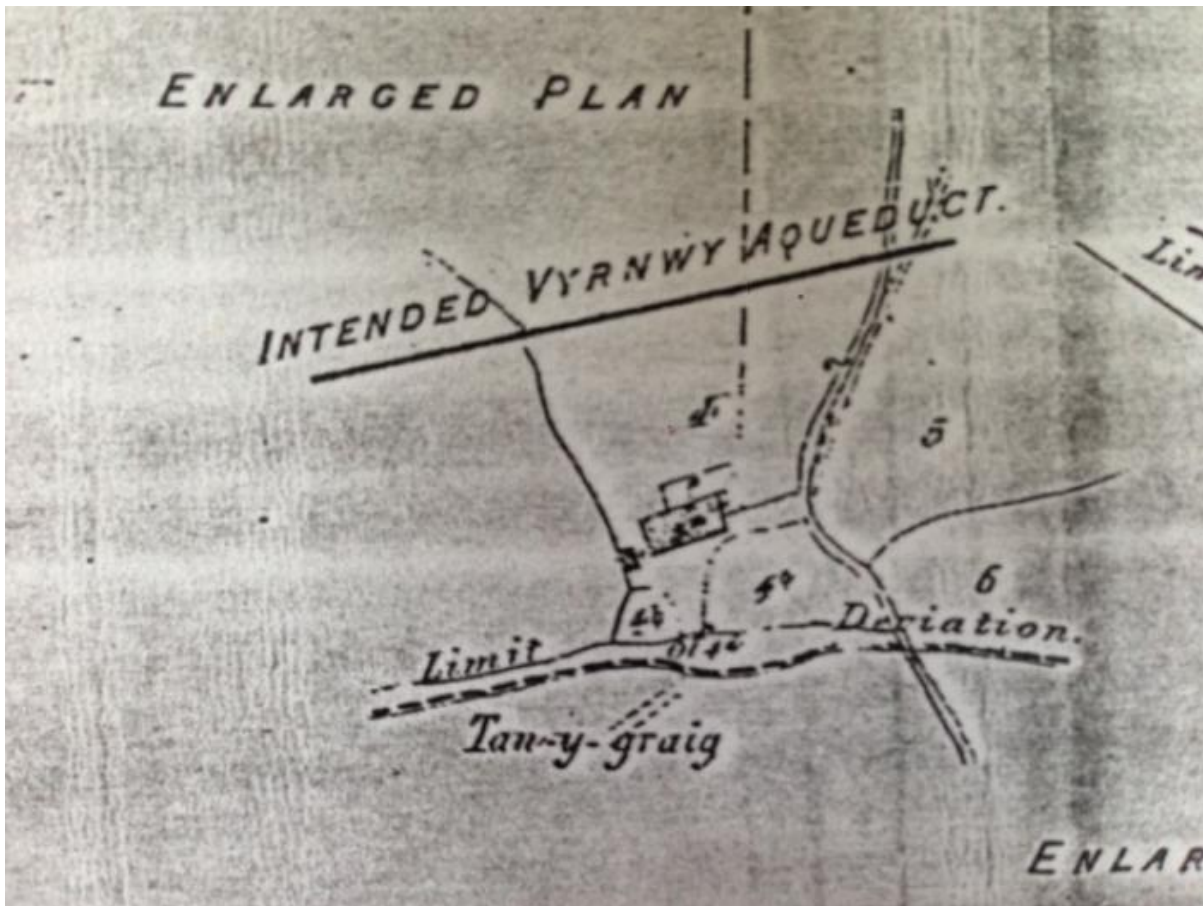


Vyrnwy Aqueduct, DP 539, 1880
