





What is your role?


I work as an Admin Assistant with the Family Information Service team. A majority what I do on a daily basis is around a procedure called "All in" which is for children with disabilities and it enables them to access activities that aren't normally available to other children and provides help for the parents. I also provide information for families that come through the early help programme.

# How has the Kickstart role improved you career and personal development?

Other jobs I had before this were in waitressing which are great, but this role has given me a completely new understanding in a new field of work for me and has helped me see how things operate and function different in administration.

One thing I have developed is my confidence and I am now no longer afraid to speak up in meetings. At the start of the role I was a little apprehensive to contribute in team meetings, but, as time has gone on and I have now know most people in the team and I have learnt to speak up and to contribute as much as I can because nobody is going to take any feedback or ideas negatively, as, giving ideas and feedback is the purpose of a team meeting. So this Kickstart role has really helped my confidence.

Yes definitely, just the experience the role has given me is massive and having the ability to put a Kickstart job on your CV is going to help massively with your future job prospects.
