found out that a lot of L2's should be L3's (i.e. had tarmac surfaces) and many suitable routes were missed off the list. Have now agreed which routes from the first survey we want to manage.

We now have another list of routes which we want to survey in part 2 which include routes that are not recorded as anything- Zia Robins has been looking at this \& Gareph Boxley has also been involved. Phase 2 will therefore include some other UCR's not in phase 1 because they are L3's (but really should be L2's) and other non-recorded sections that probably should be UCR's. Highways have agreed to record all the UCR's we take on as one category (probably Green Lane - GL) for clarity.

We await confirmation of funding from Highways before commencing the survey of phase 2 routes (probably starting in April 2010).

Discussion re: Clunton UCR - RD brought up the issue of the UCR with a missing link in the middle. RK stated that that there is no claim for this to be added with the countryside team. RK to look at phase 2 and see if this is listed if not then this is to be added. It is a popular route which is causing confusion.

RD suggested that there may be European funding for works on UCR's.

## Queries from last minutes

- Handover maps - Zia Robins has been working on these
- TS previously asked whether it was possible to what was on the list of streets at the date of commencement of the NERC Act, RK passed this onto Chris Edwards (Highways)
- The group previously asked for assurance from the Highways Department (in writing) that all UCR's are vehicular Highways, including routes where they are dual recorded as lower status ROW- This has still not been received, RK to chase at next meeting with Highways on 2/12/09.

## Signage
