

Consultation on Dog Control Orders

18.1(i)

We intend on making changes to simplify the current system of dog control relating to dog fouling, dogs on leads and the exclusion of dogs from specified land.

The existing controls are inconsistent whereby dog control orders apply in parts of the county, within the boundaries of the predecessor authorities that made dog control orders, but do not apply uniformly across the Council's area.

We invite the public to make representation / comments on its proposal to revoke existing orders and replace with three new orders to apply across the whole Shropshire Council area.

The proposal seeks to ensure that dog control across the county is consistent and reasonable.
