The Care Act will be implemented in two stages – April 2015 for general implementation and April 2016 for funding reforms.

5. Risk Assessment and Opportunities Appraisal

As the reforms to Social Care Services in Shropshire are implemented an Equality Impact Needs Assessment (EINA) will be completed.

6. Financial Implications

There are potential financial implications as the Care Bill is implemented and finance officers are modelling these. This will include both implementation costs and new burdens as a result of the Care Act.

Funding for the implementation is included in the Better Care Fund and finance officers are fully involved in allocating this.

Further funding is expected through the revenue grant and again finance officers are monitoring this and modelling the resources available against the Shropshire requirements.

7. Conclusion

Implementation of the Care Act continues in Shropshire and will progress at pace post October 2016 when the guidance is finalised.
