

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 12A (PART), PARISH OF CHELMARSH)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

The above named order made on 14th September 2018 by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will **divert**

The full width of that part of Footpath 12A in the Parish of Chelmarsh running from point A on the Order Map (SO 7179 8758) in a general south easterly direction over a natural surface to a gate. Continuing in a general south easterly direction to a stile at point B on the Order Map (SO 7185 8751); a total distance of approximately 91 metres **onto a line** from point A on the Order Map (SO 7179 8758) running in a general north easterly direction along a surfaced track, turning in a general south easterly direction through a gate then running on a natural surface in a south easterly then SSE direction to a gate at point B on the Order Map (SO 7185 8751); a total distance of approximately 124 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council's website at <https://shropshire.gov.uk/outdoor-partnerships/countryside-access-and-public-rights-of-way/current-public-path-orders/>. Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Shropshire Outdoor Partnerships, Rights of Way Mapping and Enforcement Manager, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury, SY2 6ND, or by email to outdoor.recreation@shropshire.gov.uk, not later than 12th October 2018. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
