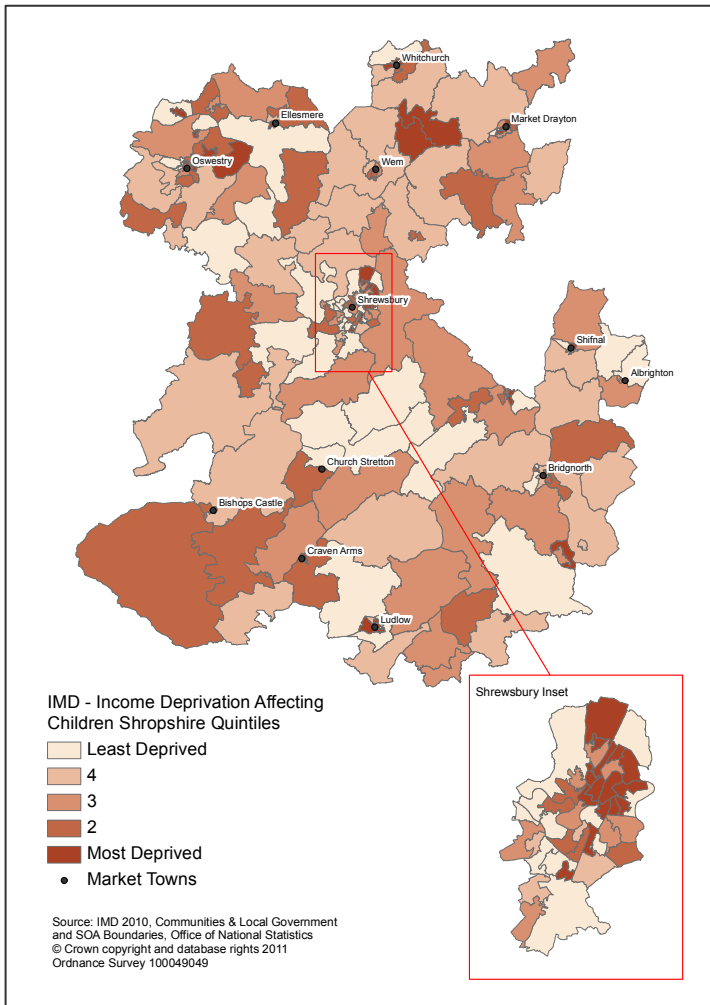


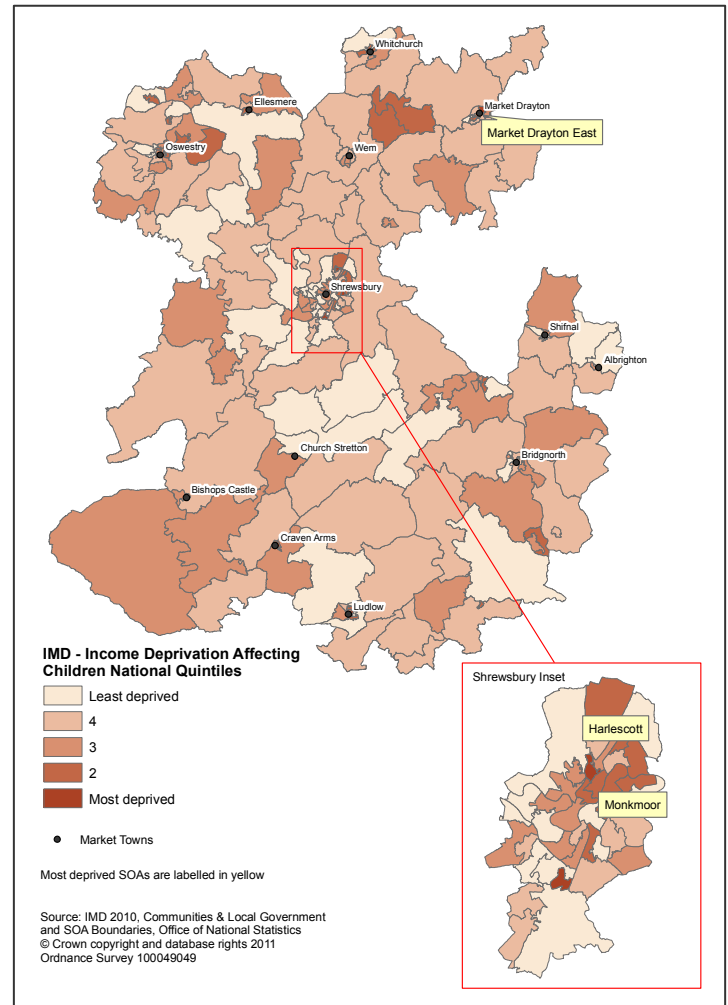


INCOME DEPRIVATION AFFECTING CHILDREN IN SHROPSHIRE (2010)

Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI)

This measures the proportion of children under 16 who are living in families in receipt of means tested benefits or in families in receipt of working families or disabled person's tax credits but whose income (before housing costs) is below 60% of the median income.

The sub index uses the same indicators as the overall income deprivation domain, but focuses on children.

There are 32,482 Lower Super Output Areas in England and each is assigned a rank in respect of the 10 Indices of Deprivation. The most deprived is given a rank of 1, and the least deprived a rank of 32,482.

There are 6 LSOAs within Shropshire which fall in the top 20% most deprived SOA's nationally in terms of the Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index.

Approximately 13% of children in Shropshire are considered to be living in income deprived households.

The number of SOAs in the least deprived quintile has risen from 32 in 2007 to 39 in 2010. The least deprived SOA falls within the former district ward of Porthill.

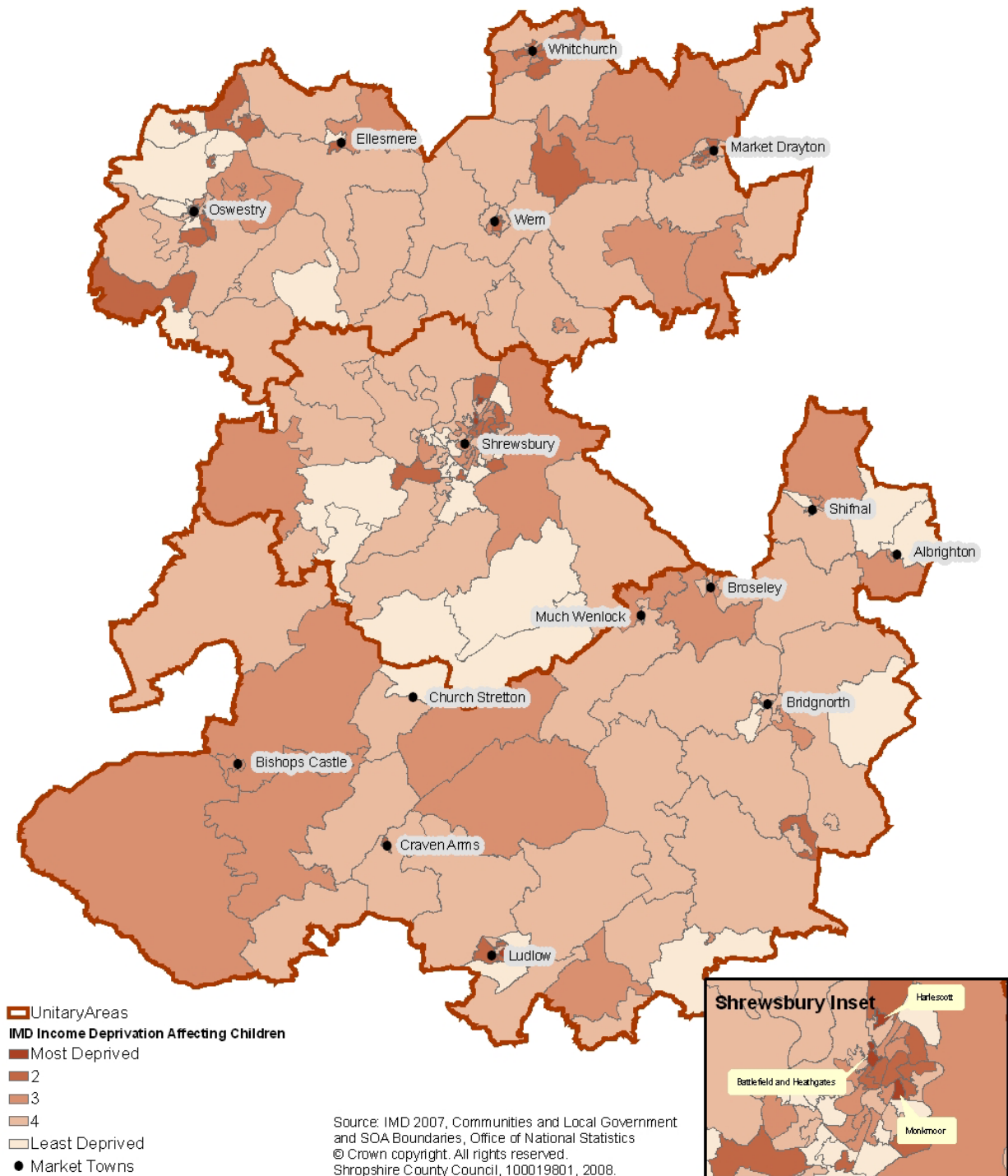

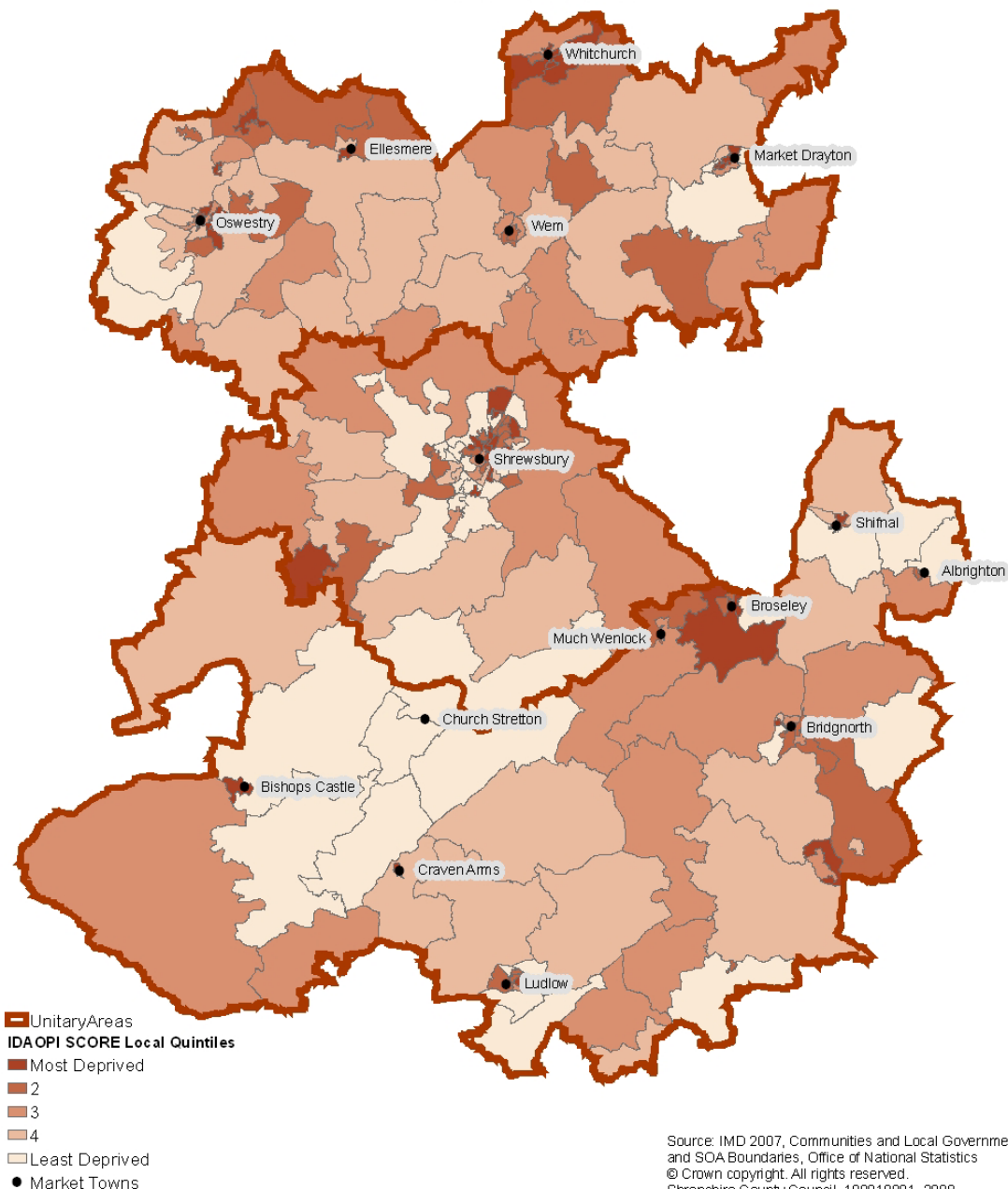

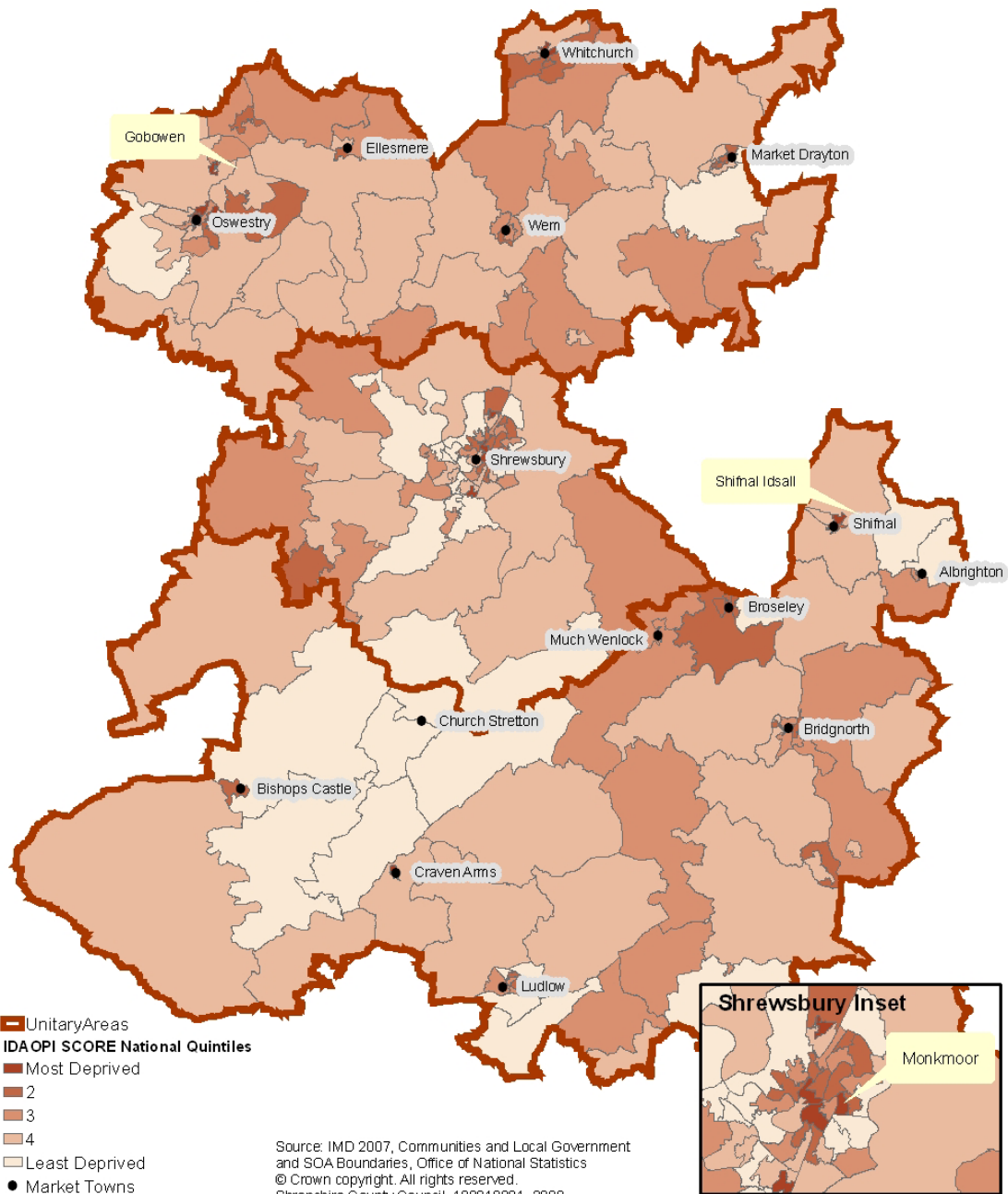


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INCOME DEPRIVATION AFFECTING OLDER PEOPLE NATIONAL RANK

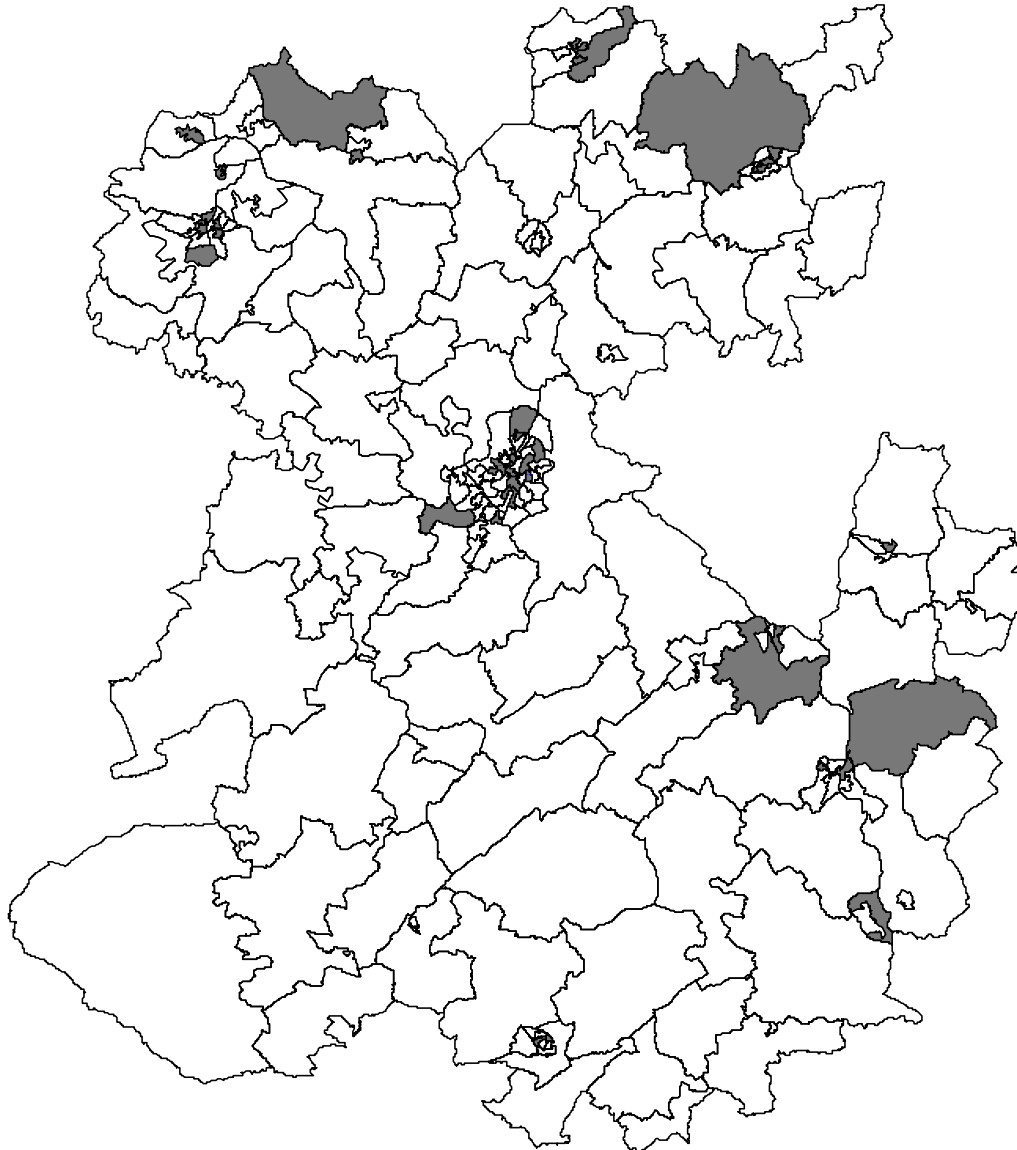

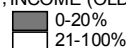
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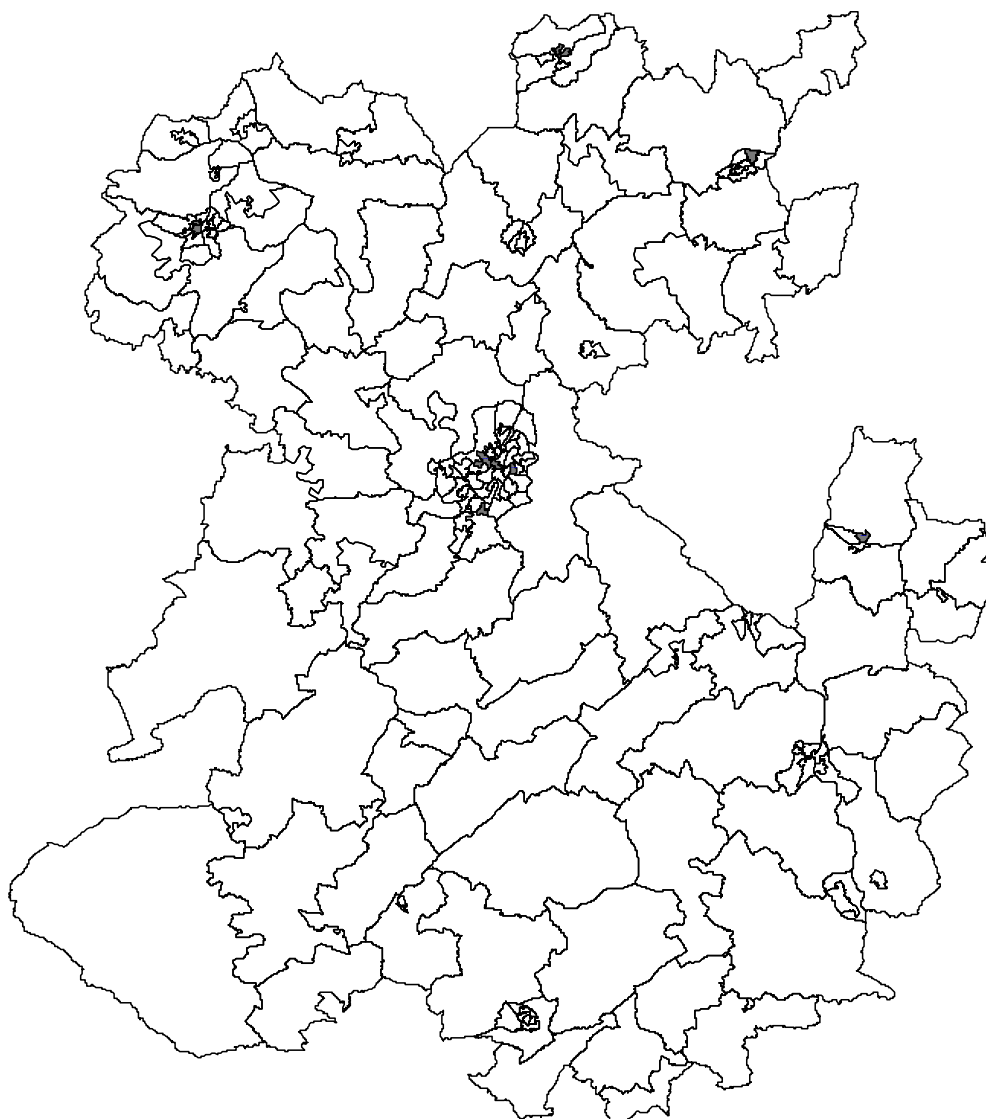
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National income affecting older people deprivation Shropshire SOA's amongst the 20% most deprived nationally

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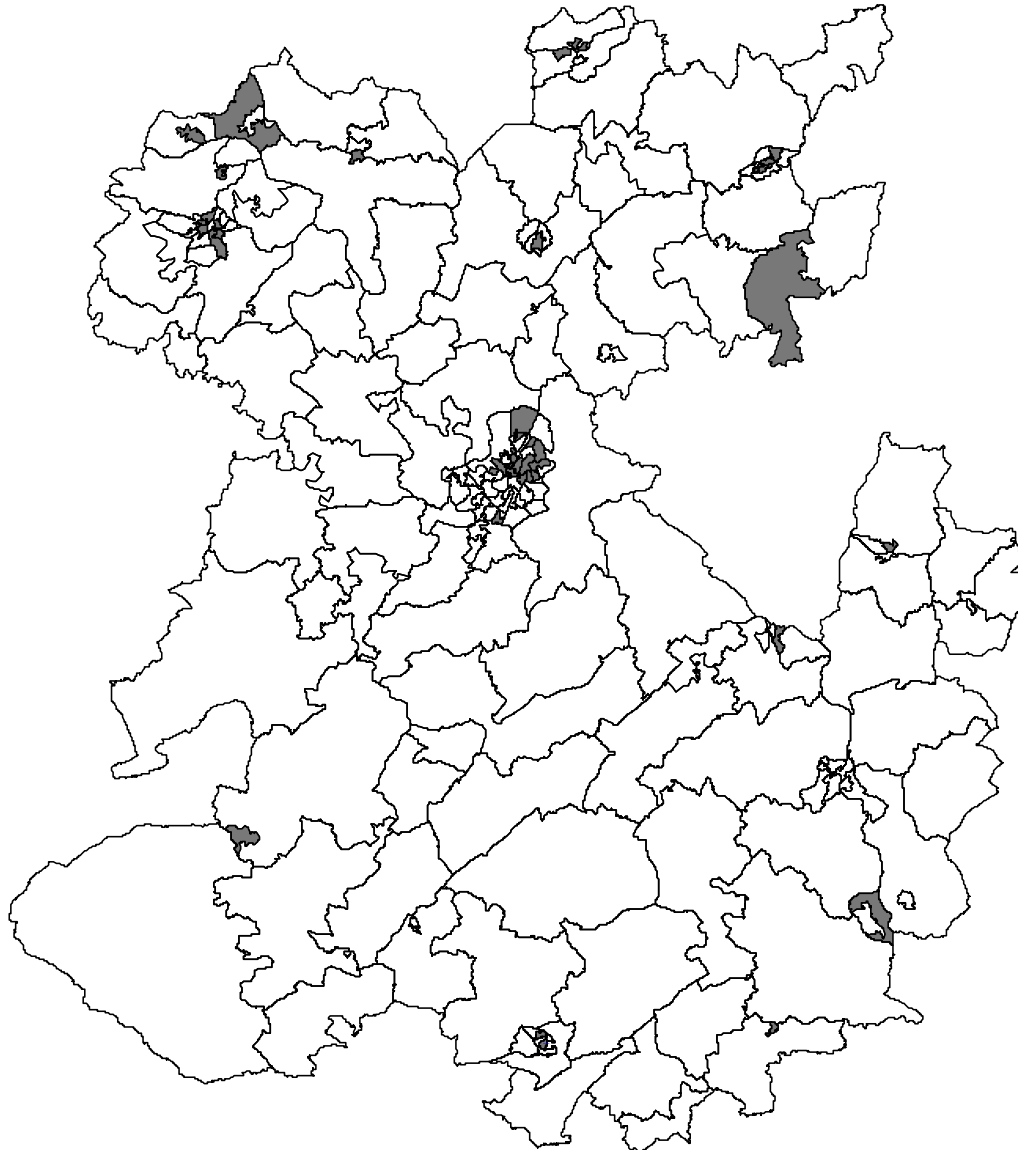

Top 20% Super Output Area's (SOA's) most deprived in Shropshire



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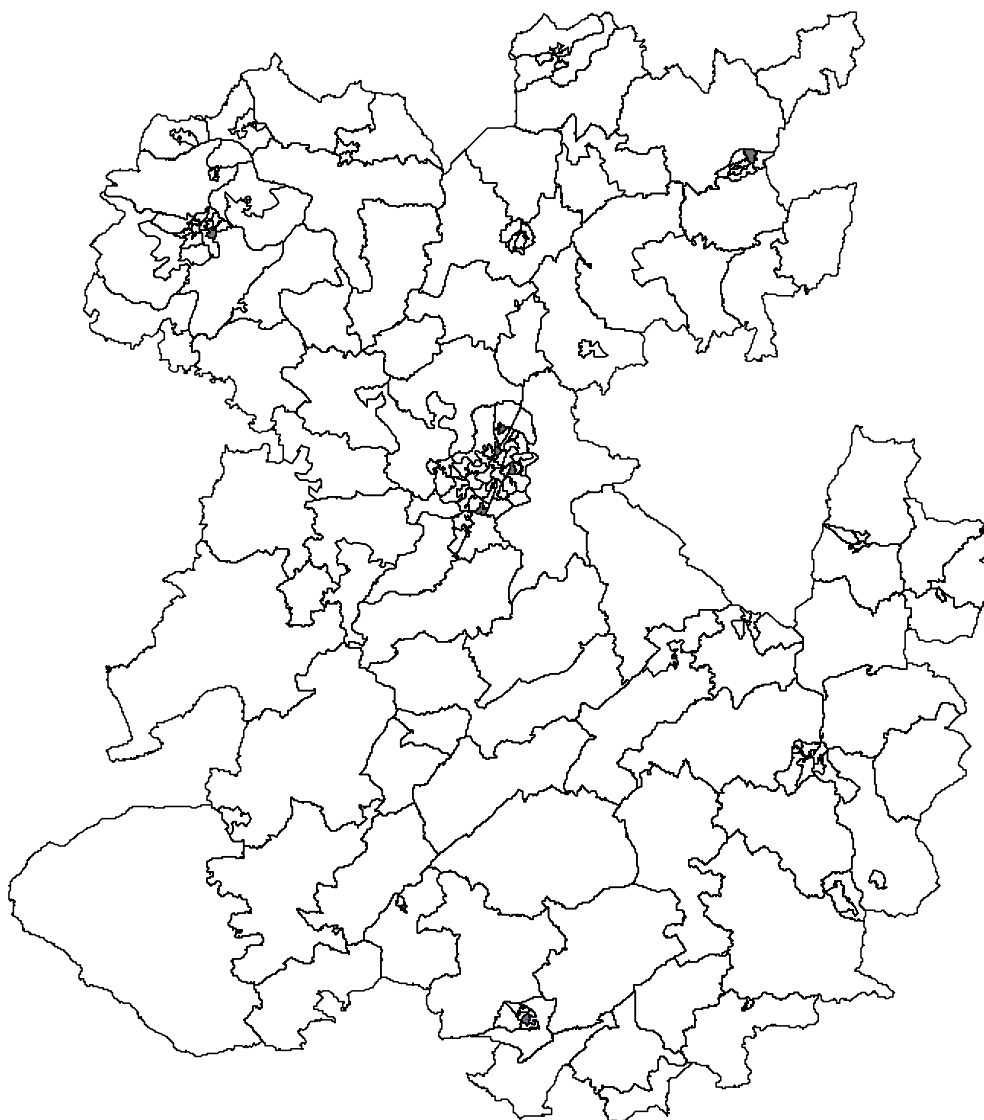

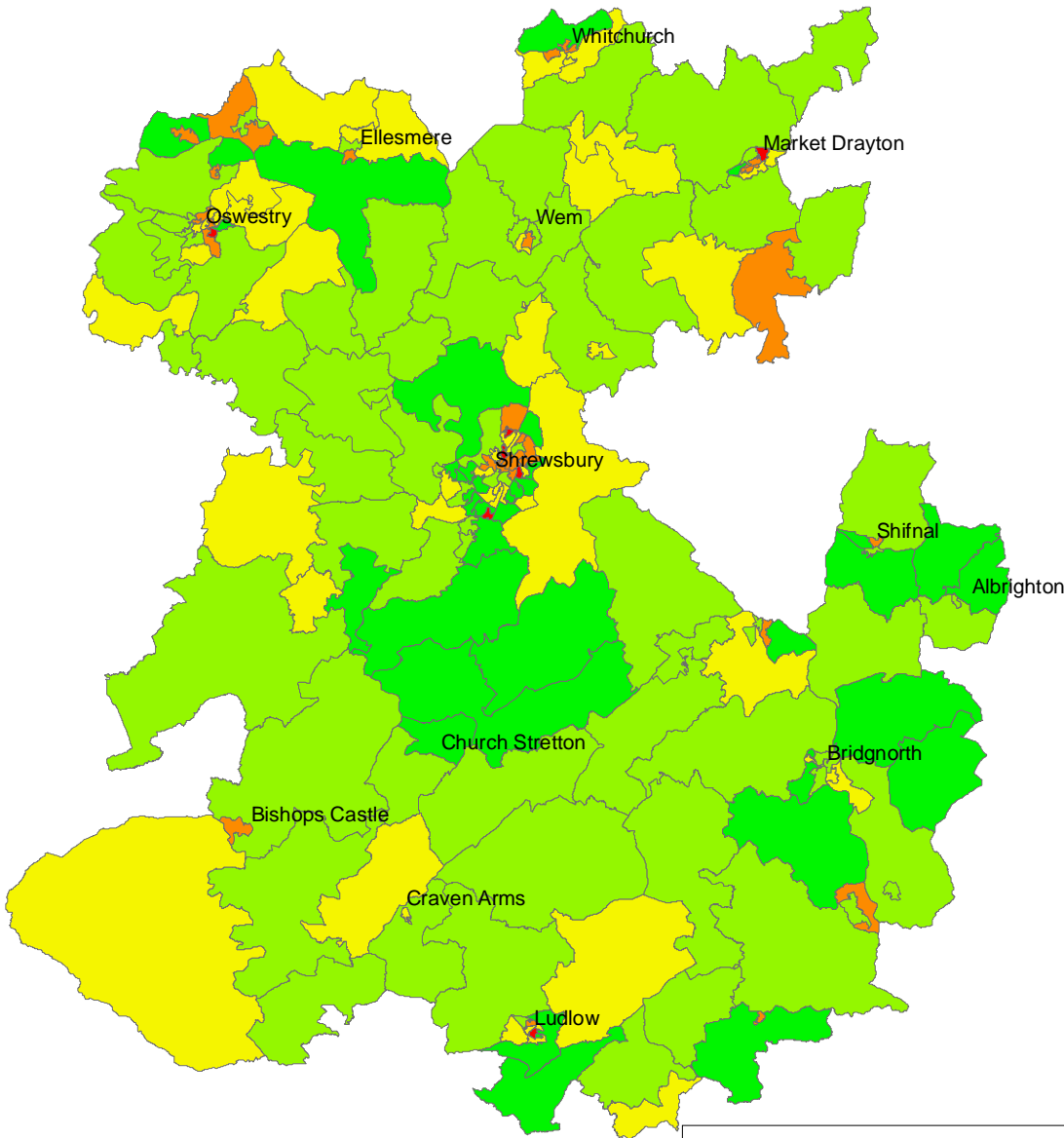

Income Affecting Children - National Quintiles



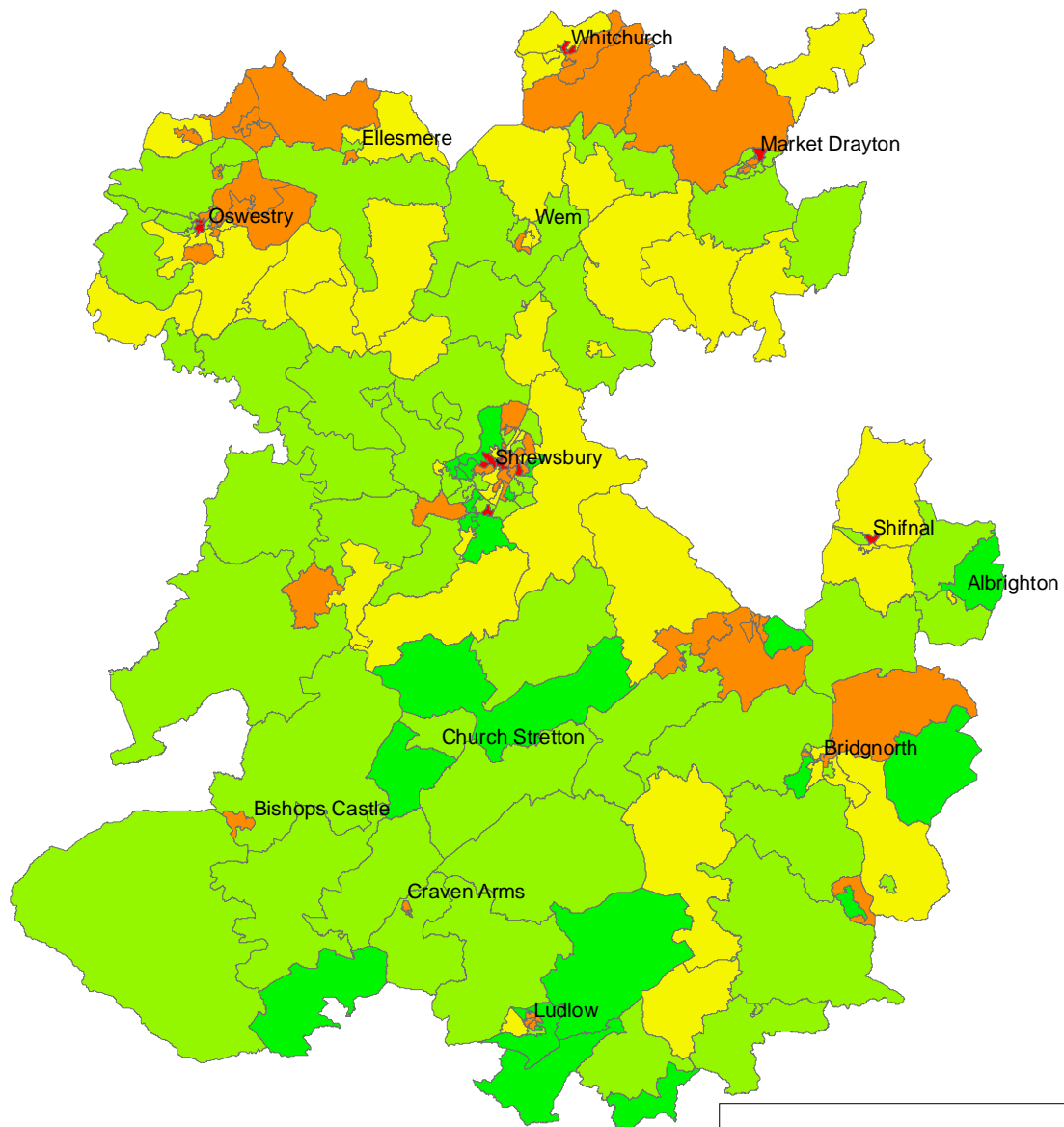

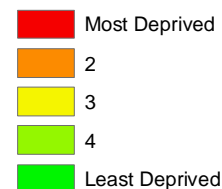
