



A Guide to **Services for People with a Physical Disability**

Community Services

In order to maintain your independence, you may require support and information. Social Care can provide:

Community Care Assessments

For care and support at home, residential care, day care or other services

Occupational Therapy Assessments

For adaptations to property and equipment for daily living

Carer Assessments

For people supporting or living with someone who has a disability

Registration

Registration as physically disabled with Shropshire Council is available to those who meet the criteria of being "permanently and substantially disabled"

Making a referral

Anyone may make a referral to our teams on behalf of themselves or someone else, providing the consent of that person has been obtained

Help may include

- providing equipment such as a raised toilet seat or grab rail
- advice and information for carers, including family members and friends
- adapting your home
- providing a blue parking badge
- telling you about day time activities in your area
- signposting to other community services



My Life, My Choice - changes in the way you receive support

Transformation of Adult Social Care is a national programme to enhance social care and provide support that is geared around the person to enable them to be as independent as possible. In Shropshire we are now looking at the way we deliver services and this will mean some changes in how our services work.

Shropshire's 'My Life, My Choice' programme will be an exciting way of giving more choice and control to people who need support with their care. We will be looking at how we can provide information and guidance to everyone who needs extra support and to offer 'personal budgets' to people who meet the eligibility for social care funding.

A Personal Budget is an amount of money which the Council allocates to help people who need support due to disability, frailty or vulnerability to get the support they want. We will be working in a different way, in order to give you more choice and control over how that money is spent.
