## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 22 (PART) PARISH OF UPTON MAGNA) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

On 24<sup>th</sup> November 2022, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to **divert** the full width of that part of Footpath 22, Upton Magna, from point A on the order map (SJ 5567 1251) where it leaves, Pelham Road, running in a general easterly direction across the garden and corner of number 10 Pelham Road, then continues across the garden of number 9 Pelham Road before crossing a field to point B on the order map (SJ 5580 1250); a total distance of approximately 131 metres; **onto a line** from a gate at point B on the order map (SJ 5580 1250), a footpath to be created running in a general west-north-westerly direction following a field boundary to a pedestrian gate in the hedge line at point C on the order map (SJ 5569 1257) at its junction with Pelham Road; a total distance of approximately 124 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 28<sup>th</sup> October 2022; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 24<sup>th</sup> November 2022 make an application to the High Court.
