

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION
OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP
AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 37 (PART) PARISH OF CRAVEN
ARMS)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2022**

On 6th April 2023, The Shropshire Council (the “Council”) confirmed the above named order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to **divert** the full width of that part of Footpath 37 from point A on the Order Map (SO 4283 8337) running in a northerly direction for approximately 48 metres before turning east for 19 metres up to point B on the Order Map (SO 4285 8342). Total distance to be extinguished is approximately 67 metres **onto a line** from point A on the Order Map (SO 4283 8337) a footpath will be created in a general NNE direction to connect with the current route on Hopesay Hill Road at point B on the Order Map (SO 4285 8342). The proposed path is approximately 53 metres in length. The proposed path will have a width of 1.5m and runs along a combination of natural surface and tarmacked path.

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 19th January 2023 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 6th April 2023 make an application to the High Court.
