

### PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53(A)(2)

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 7 (PART) TOWN OF SHREWSBURY & PARISH OF BICTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023.

This order is made by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to allow for a mixed residential development of 340 mixed (including 51 affordable units) with associated garages; creation of vehicular access(es); installation of infrastructure, footpath links, public open space, and biodiversity enhancement areas. (amended description) Development Land At Churncote Off Welshpool Road Bicton Heath Shrewsbury.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981Act") because it appears to the authority that the Shropshire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

#### BY THIS ORDER:

 The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted, and the Shropshire definitive map and statement shall be modified as provided below.

- There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Shropshire Council
  an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as
  provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the
  attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Shropshire Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with and upon occurrence of that diversion the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it the way referred to in paragraph 1 of this order and the way referred to in paragraph 2 of this order shall be added to it and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the schedule.
- 4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

#### SCHEDULE

#### PARTI

#### Description of site of existing path or way

The full width of that part of FP 7 to be extinguished running from FP 8Y at point A on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4523 1346 running in a general north westerly direction to point B on the Order Map at GR SJ 4505 1367. A total distance of approximately 275 metres.

## PART 2

## Description of site of alternative highway

Leaving Welshpool Road at point C on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4527 1340 the footpath to be created runs in a general WNW then northerly direction on a natural surface through the public open space (POS) with a width of 2 metres to join the estate road. The footpath will then follow the pavement of the estate road in a general northerly, then easterly, NNE, WNW, northerly then easterly direction to grid reference SJ 4511 1360. From here the footpath runs on a surfaced path around the eastern then northern edge of the POS before continuing in a northerly direction on a surfaced path with a width of 2 metres to re-join the Definitive line of FP 7 at point B on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4505 1367. A total approximate distance of 476 metres.

## PART 3

#### **Modification of Definitive Statement**

Leaving Welshpool Road at point C on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4527 1340 the footpath to be created runs in a general WNW then northerly direction on a natural surface through the public open space (POS) with a width of 2 metres to join the estate road. The footpath will then follow the pavement of the estate road in a general northerly, then easterly, NNE, WNW, northerly then easterly direction to grid reference SJ 4511 1360. From here the footpath runs on a surfaced path around the eastern then northern edge of the POS before continuing in a northerly direction on a surfaced path with a width of 2 metres to re-join the Definitive line of FP 7 at point B on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 4505 1367. A total approximate distance of 476 metres.

There is no Shropshire definitive statement for the remainder of FP 7 Shrewsbury & Bicton.
