

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981  
THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 29 PARISH OF WORTHEN WITH SHELVE)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023.**

The above named order made on 11<sup>th</sup> May 2023 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert

The full width of Footpath 29 leaving the Hemford to Hope Park Road at Point A on the Order Map at grid reference SO 3307 0099 running in a general south easterly then ESE direction through the property and over a pasture field to exit onto the Bentlawnt to Gravels Road at point B on the Order Map at grid reference SO 3316 0085. A total distance of approximately 107 metres **onto a line** from a stile on the Hemford to Hope Park Road at point C on the Order Map, grid reference SO 3316 0104 running in a general ESE direction on a natural surface to a stile on the Bentlawnt to Gravels Road at point D on the Order Map at grid reference SO 3321 0102. A total distance of approximately 57 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
