

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 61 (PART) PARISH OF CARDINGTON)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023.**

The above named order made on 9th November 2023 by the Shropshire Council (“the Council”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert

The full width of that part of Footpath 61 commencing from the junction of BW’s 7 & 8 at grid reference SO 4915 9389 at point A on the Order Map, running in a general north westerly direction to grid reference SO 4909 9394 at point B on the Order Map. Total distance approximately 85 metres onto a line from a gate leading off from BW 7 at grid reference SO 4913 9398 at point C on the Order Map running in a general NNW direction to a gate then continuing in a general WSW then southerly direction to re-join the Definitive line of FP 61 at a gate at grid reference SO 4909 9394, point B on the Order Map. An approximate distance of 90 metres on a natural surface with a varying width of between 1-2 metres throughout.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
