### THE APPLICATION ROUTE

5. The application route is shown marked blue on the plan below:

- a. Point A (end of bridleway 22 and formerly site of Frog Mill), passing along a track through woodland before becoming a clear track over fields, through a bridledway gate beside a farm gate then along lane to Linley Old Station at Point B where it joins the Severn Way.

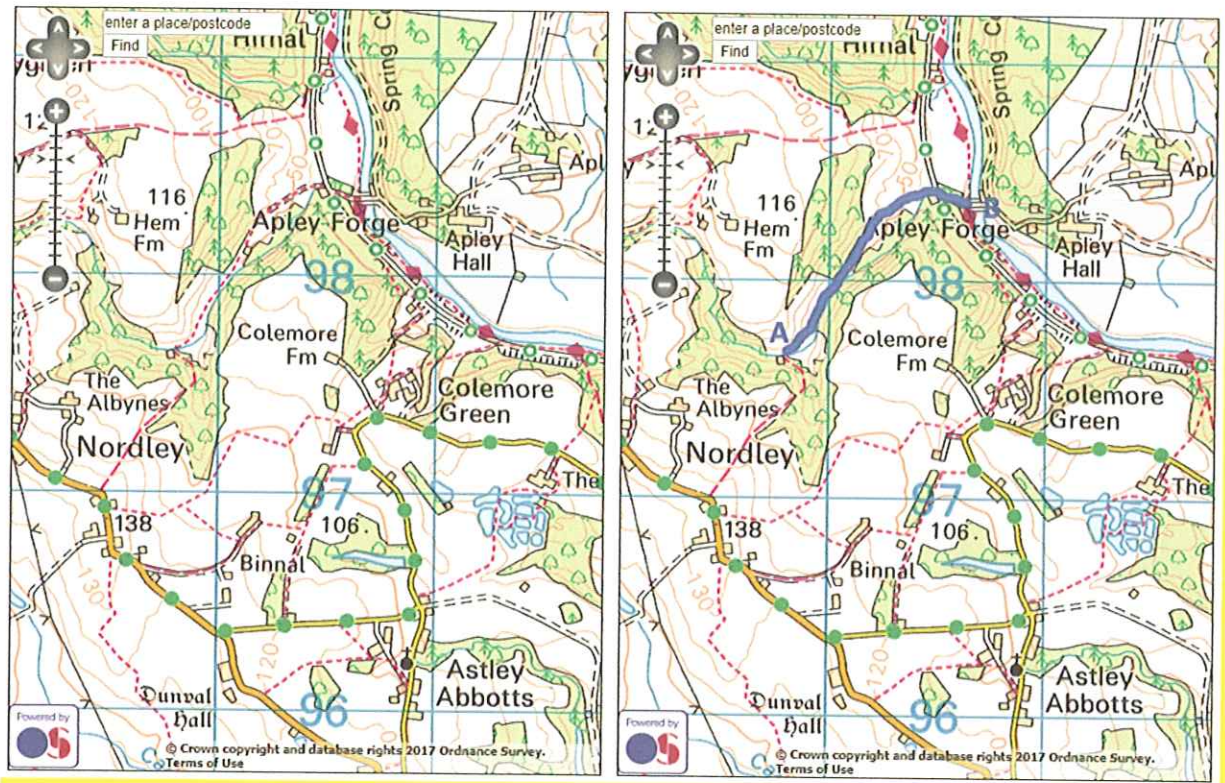


Figure 1: Ordnance Survey, 2017, 1:25000 scale map extract showing application route
