1	A local resident said that resurfacing of the roads on the Bushfield Road estate were required and asked when this would be carried out.	Alice Dilly – Principal Engineer Road Safety	There is allocated funding this financial year to carry out further phase resurfacing of roads on Bushfields Estate however at this stage we cannot confirm which roads these will be. It is anticipated to carry out the works before Christmas and they are likely to have commenced by the next LJC. We are liaising with the Parish Council over this.
2	Another local resident again raised an issue about overgrown ivy obscuring street lights in Cross Road/Elm, Road. He said that he had raised the issue on other occasions at the LJC over the last 12 months or so and been promised that the ivy would be cut back. He also raised an issue about the location of the speed limit near Cross Road suggesting that the 40mph zone and signs were in the wrong place.	Jason Hughes Street Lighting & Traffic Signals Team Leader	<p>I have checked with Division on the progress of the cutting back of the ivy which I had been informed was to be done months ago. Some, however, not all was removed due to the explanation below. Prysmian our Street Lighting term maintenance contractor will be attending site today (Monday 23rd May) to complete the remainder of the foliage removal.</p> <p>I have contacted Mr Evans this afternoon and apologised for the unacceptable delay and confirmed that the ivy should be gone by the end of the day.
