The problem has not re-occurred.</p> <p>The local neighbourhood policing team are aware and monitoring the situation.</p>

37	The Chairman asked for further details of the costs of installing a bridge for pedestrians alongside Crowmeole Lane.	Alison Kennedy	Shropshire Council Bridge Engineer John Williams has provided the following information regarding estimated cost of installing a footbridge alongside Crowmeole Lane Road Bridge:

			<p>"If you assume that it will be possible to provide a bridge that has relatively shallow foundations, I suggest that an initial budget allocation of £100,000 to cover the combined design and construction costs would be reasonable. That should be adequate to cover the provision of both the bridge and its approaches.</p> <p>Please note that if the ground conditions prove to be poor and deeper foundations are therefore required, eg piles, the cost is likely to be greater than this. Say up to £130,000."</p>
36	Young people at the meeting said the Youth Shelter was inappropriately located. It was agreed to look into the possibility of moving it.	Gwyn Bevan	Gwyn Bevan has established it would cost as much to move the Youth Shelter as purchase a new one. He is currently working with the Youth Club to identify an alternative site which may be on the playing field belonging to Shrewsbury Town Council by Pump Lane. Additional lighting at the proposed site by the Multi Use Games Area may suffice.
