51	Lead Officer to look into delay in response to request for information regarding speed limit reduction to roads in Gains Park and provide the information needed	Nick Taylor/Alice Dilly	The urban speed limit policy is currently in draft format and the proposed speed limit reductions in Shrewsbury (which includes those roads mentioned) are 3rd in the priority ranking for delivery, behind Bridgnorth and Ellesmere. The priority ranking has been based on casualties per 100,000 population (over a 3 year period). Although a prioritised listing has been put together of towns to be tackled in order, this is under the heading of the Urban Speed Limit Review and there is no funding this current year so the earliest any of these measures would be delivered would be next financial year.
52	Is Early World Nursery moving out of its current location in Gains Park?	Nick Taylor/Neville Ward	Early World is a privately run organisation although we do provide them with information, support and guidance as part of our statutory duty to support the provision of high quality childcare across the county. We have had no information from Early World to suggest that they may be moving. To our knowledge they have not submitted an application to Ofsted to relocate to new premises and they would have to do this some way in advance of any move they may have planned.
