59	<p>Bins on A5 and A49 often full and overflowing and of unpleasant appearance when entering Shrewsbury.</p> <p>The Committee asked that a letter be written requesting information on emptying arrangements and suggesting bins are emptied more regularly</p>	Nick Taylor	<p>Nick Taylor contacted the Street Scene Manager (Central) who has supplied the following information:</p> <p>At present all litter bins on the A5/A49 by pass within the Central area are emptied on a weekly basis and the lay bys litter picked. At present they are emptied on a Saturday but as a cost efficiency we are going to include this work within the working week. The frequency of emptying does increase to twice a week during the summer months due to the increased usage of these roads. If for any reason the bins become overflowing during the week we will endeavour to empty them prior to the scheduled emptying.</p>
