## FUNDING APPLICATIONS

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### 1. Summary

This report provides the Committee with details of all allocations from the 2009/10 Community Chest funding of £10,000. Current bids for funding from the 2010 – 11 Community Chest of £10,000 are outlined for consideration.

### 2. Purpose of the Report

To update members on the funding allocated to date and recent applications for funding

### 3. Recommendations

The Committee is recommended to approve suggested amounts of funding as detailed in the table at 5 which includes an allocation of £1,500 to MUGA on a provisional basis, dependent upon the outcome of the bid to the Football Foundation in December 2010.

#### 4. Report

The 2009/10 Community Chest fund of £10,000 was allocated as follows:

An amount of £2,000 was allocated to the Mount Nursery to refurbish the demountable at the Dark Lane school site but this was later declined therefore leaving a balance of £2000.26 to be added to the 2010/11 fund.

#### 5. Current applications

The Committee has a budget of £10,000 for the 2010/11 financial year. With the amount of £2,000.26 carried over from the 2009/10 fund, this makes a total of £12,000.26 to be allocated.
