Summary

This report provides information on the allocation of the budget.

Report

The Committee has agreed to use £10,000 of its annual allocation of £20,000, to support projects/activities determined by the Committee to be a priority for Broseley and Barrow, with the other half being used for organisations to bid for funding from a community chest.

The development of the Birchmeadow Centre remains a high priority and a range of funding streams are being explored. A proposal is currently being made by the Birchmeadow Centre Management Committee to Shropshire Council's Community Fund in order to extend the ground floor of the Birchmeadow Centre to create a café.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the LJC approves, on a provisional basis, pending the decision on the bid to the Shropshire Council Community Fund, £5,000 to provide match funding which will enhance the viability of the bid.

It is recommended that the Committee considers the use of the remaining £5,000 in the LJC fund.
