10.3 Bus Strategy for Shropshire 2011- 2016 - Consultation

Local Transport Plan – Consultation

Shropshire Council are facing difficult decisions in the short and medium term, as financial pressures increase on the budget for the provision of supported local bus services. This will affect the delivery and sustainability of bus services in all areas of the county. Shropshire Council must ensure that the money which is available is targeted at bus services which are essential in enabling people to go about their daily lives.

Shropshire Council are consulting with people across Shropshire during January to March 2011 about proposed changes to local bus services. These changes will be laid out in the Bus Strategy for Shropshire Council 2011- 2016. The Strategy and details on how to respond to the consultation can be viewed at;

In addition council officers are holding a series of consultation events to answer any questions on the bus strategy and record any comments in response to the consultation. There will be a roadshow at Broseley Library on 3 March (10.00 a.m – 1.00 p.m).

12. Dates and Venues of meetings in 2011/12

As a result of the changes to LJsCs agreed by Shropshire Council on 9 December 2010, the Much Wenlock and Broseley divisions will join together to create a new LJC which will operate a two zone principle; one for Much Wenlock with surrounding parishes and one for Broseley and Barrow.

Both local Shropshire Council members will each have a voting place at each zoned meeting, but the parish representatives will only have a vote within their own zone. Broseley will meet twice a year chaired by the

Broseley member with a ring fenced budget, and Much Wenlock will meet twice per year chaired by the Much Wenlock member with a ring fenced budget.

Members are considering holding the two Broseley and Barrow Sub Committee meetings in 2011/12 in April and October 2011.
