COMMUNITY CHEST SCHEME

What is the Community Chest Scheme?

The Community Chest Scheme aims to assist the work of community and voluntary groups based, or working in the Cleobury Mortimer area.

The Scheme can offer grants of up to 50% of total project costs up to a maximum grant of £500. This can be towards a wide variety of projects that assist the community. Some examples of the types of project it will fund are:

- Purchase or hire of equipment
- Publicity material
- Newsletters and leaflets
- Small scale repairs to village halls
- Development of community services
- Training

Who is eligible to apply?

Any constituted community group, registered charity, Town / Parish Council and Parish Meeting based, or working in the parishes listed below. The group will also need a bank account.
