

# Shrewsbury North West Relief Road

# 13

## About the road

The road would run from the Churncote roundabout west of Shrewsbury where the A5 dual carriageway ends to the roundabout on the Ellesmere Road west of Battlefield. We think the proposed road would ease traffic on some of the most used roads in Shrewsbury town centre and the rural communities to the west of the town, making the town more attractive to live in, work in and visit. It could also support the development of the town as a growth point.

Taking advantage of the reduced traffic, Smithfield Road would be remodelled to give pedestrians and cyclists more space along the riverside. The project has been identified as one of the transport priorities across the West Midlands.

We will be reviewing the business case for the road and the results of the consultation in July and deciding at that time whether to submit the business case to the Department for Transport for funding.
