Summary

This report sets out the Leader's proposals for the appointment of Cabinet Members for the year 2009/10, their portfolios and remits. Report

1. Background

1.1 Under Shropshire Council's Executive Procedure Rules, at the Annual Meeting of the Council, the Leader presents to Council a document containing information about Executive functions in relation to the following year. This contains the names, addresses and electoral divisions of the people to be appointed to the Executive, the extent of any authority delegated to Executive

members individually, the terms of reference and constitution of any Executive Committees as the Leader proposes, the nature and extent of any delegation of Executive functions under a joint arrangement. These are all Leader appointments, in accordance with the legislation.

2. Proposals

- 2.1. The proposals in respect of the appointments to the Cabinet and the titles and remits of the various portfolios and the Cabinet Member to hold those portfolios are set out in Appendix 1.
- 2.2. West Mercia Supplies Joint Committee exercises executive functions through its Board and the Shropshire Primary Care Trust also exercises executive functions through the Joint Member Board. The Leader will appoint 3 Cabinet members to each Board.
