(b) Joint working between the scrutiny committees will take place at a joint themed meeting where the matter will be considered. Or through a joint task and finish group that will consist of members of the panels involved and will undertake their work outside of the Scrutiny Panel meetings, reporting back to a meeting of the joint panel. - (c) If it is decided that a Scrutiny Panel will conduct the review individually then they shall invite the Chair of the other committee (or his/her nominee) to attend its meetings when the matter is being reviewed.
- (d) Before submitting its findings to the Executive (Cabinet) and/or Council for consideration, the report of the reviewing Scrutiny Committee shall be considered by the other Scrutiny Committee for comment. Those comments shall be incorporated into the report which is then sent to that body for consideration.
