Shropshire Core Strategy: Final Plan Version

The purpose of the report was to introduce the draft Final Plan version of the Core Strategy document (attached as Appendix A) for consideration and endorsement by members. This was the fourth stage in the process of developing Shropshire's Core Strategy. Following approval it would be published on 15th February 2010 for a 6 week period for representations.

Shropshire Regeneration Prospectus

The Shropshire Regeneration Prospectus performed two main roles:

The Council's Local Investment plan – part of the “single conversation” with the Homes and Communities Agency and other public sector funding bodies;

The Local Development Framework (LDF) Implementation Plan, an integral part of how we demonstrate that the LDF Core Strategy is deliverable. Integrating these two purposes in one document was considered to be ambitious but logical. It presented a coherent package and illustrated the “golden thread” from Community Strategy vision, through strategy to delivery. Although the Council had not yet finalised its five year Capital Strategy, there was a need to publish a draft of the Regeneration Prospectus early in 2010 to accompany the LDF Core Strategy (see separate report). The Council was also seeking to reach agreement with the HCA on the Local Investment Plan aspect by the end of March 2010 at the latest.

Cabinet agreed:

(a) That, subject to further consideration being given to barn conversions, Council be recommended to approve the draft Final Plan document for publication subject to minor amendments and editing.

(b) That authority be delegated to the Director of Development Services in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Strategic Planning and Transport to approve the Final Plan document prior to publication for public consultation on 15th February 2010.

Cabinet agreed:

A. Approves the Council's draft Regeneration Prospectus (appendix 1) to be published alongside the LDF Core Strategy as its Implementation Plan.

B. Agrees that the draft Regeneration Prospectus be used to support the negotiations with the Homes and Communities Agency as part of the Single Conversation.
