Summary

Ten organisations have submitted bids in the second round of funding to be considered by Gobowen, Selattyn, St Martins and Weston Rhyn Local Joint Committee (LJC).

Recommendation

The Committee are asked to approve the recommended award for funding.

REPORT

1. Selattyn, Gobowen, St Martins and Weston Rhyn Local Joint Committee (LJC) have £32,000 allocated to it from Shropshire Council to award to eligible, appropriate and agreed projects.
2. At its meeting on 15th July 2009 the LJC agreed the process and principles to be implemented in relation to the allocation of these funds.
3. At its meeting on 7th October 2009, the LJC agreed to allocate £4,455.10 to 5 projects. This left a total of £27, 544.90 for the LJC to commit.
4. Attached at Appendix A is a resume of the projects received in the second round of applications. The Appendix also details the recommended level of funding for each project.
5. If approved the total amount awarded in this round will amount to £16,430.90 leaving £11,114 to be used for applications in the third round which will be considered at the next LJC meeting.
6. The LJC is asked to approve the recommended award for funding.
