| 3.8 | St Martins Playing Field Committee New Protective Fencing | New Fencing is required at 2 positions on the playing field to protect adjacent properties. St Martins Football Club have been promoted to West Midlands League and changes to meet the new league's specifications include extending playing area and moving and raising the height of protective fences adjacent to houses. The site is leased by Shropshire Council's Parks and Countryside Unit (Ellesmere office) who will seek planning permission for the works but cannot provide funding.
