4.4	St Martins Senior Swimming Club	St Martins Senior Swimming Club use the pool in Rhyn Park School once a week during term time for swimming and gentle exercise. There is a hoist to aid the more physically disabled. Most of them would find it too difficult to get to Oswestry Leisure Centre. However this means that they have to pay for hire of pool, annual insurance plus a lifeguard themselves.	£691	£691

4.2	Gobowen scouts	To prepare, train and equip 9 scouts before they go to the International World Scout Jamboree in Sweden. They are doing a huge amount of fundraising around the area, with confirmed support from the Rotary, bag packing and raffles. The total costs are £16,200 mostly made up of costs of going to Sweden. They have asked LJC for a contribution towards the English Lead-up, with practice camps, day events and clothing.	Up to £891, see below.	£450
4.3	Weston Rhyn Village Hall Emergency damp repairs to accommodation	The upstairs accommodation is in desperate need of insulation and re-plastering, as an emergency ahead of any of the large renovation grants that the hall will be applying for. Some of this work can be done by volunteers and they are asking mainly for costs of materials.	£2,862	£1,000
4.5	Aqueducts (Friends of Pontcysyllte Aqueduct and Llangollen Canal World Heritage Site)	For activities, events and general support and development for one year on the English portion of the WHS as it applies to local interested people from the three parishes. This breaks down into hire of meeting room and speakers, events, plus website development and photocopier/printer plus other printing and promotional costs for English activities.	£2,315	£1,000
