## INTEGRATED PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT

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### Introduction

This brief report provides an update on the development of an integrated performance management framework for health and care.

This is necessary to enable the Joint Member Board to receive regular information on progress, outcomes and activity, to inform their oversight of the work programme for Joint Commissioning.

This report is linked to the Joint Strategic Needs Assessment – which is a yearly update on key outcome areas, providing the data required to track the changing needs of the people of Shropshire and the impacts of health and care services commissioned on their behalf.

The <u>attached sheet</u> shows the areas that will be included for consideration as part of the integration of performance reporting and management.

This is subject to further more detailed work between the Performance and Finance teams at the Council and PCT, particularly in terms of best use of existing systems to capture, collate and analyse the data required.

When the systems are established to integrate the information it is proposed that a 'dashboard' will be used (mapped out in the attached sheet) to hold and present the key data. This will facilitate the analysis of the information by key partners and partnership boards.

The dashboard is in draft form and suggestions are welcomed about the content or use of this model.
