Loton and Tern Local Joint Committee Funding Guidelines 2011/12

The Loton and Tern Local Joint Committee (LJC) has a budget of £17,000 for the 2011/12 financial year. The Committee encourages community groups from within the LJC area to apply to the Committee for funding, based on the following basic criteria:

- 1. The Local Joint Committee will normally only consider funding up to a maximum of £2,000 per project. A separate small grants scheme is also available for grants of up to £350 (these small grants can be 100% funded).
- 2. Projects applying to the Local Joint Committee must notify their local parish council of their application.
- 3. The Local Joint Committee will give priority to bids where additional matched funding has been secured. The Committee recommends that projects of over £350 provide 50% matched funding for their projects. The Community Action officer can help you look for and apply for matched funding.

4. In 2011/12 the Local Joint Committee would like to encourage applications from projects that bring community benefit to people living within the LJC area, and encourage community cohesion.

- 5. The Local Joint Committee may consider in-kind contributions as additional investment (such as free staff time, room hire)
- 6. One-off revenue costs (such as staff time, room hire) for events will be eligible for funding and will be considered by the Local Joint Committee.
- 7. Bids for ongoing revenue costs (such as staff time, room hire) will not be eligible for funding and will not be considered by the Local Joint Committee.
- 8. Applicants should demonstrate in their bids how the ongoing revenue costs associated with projects will be met.
- 9. Copies of 3 quotes for the work you wish to carry out are normally required with applications.

The Local Joint Committee will meet twice in 2011/12 to assess the applications they receive. Applications should be submitted one month ahead of these meetings. The meeting dates for 2011/12 are:

Thursday 7th July 2011 and Thursday 2nd February 2012
