The event is being organised by Sam Martin to raise funds for charity and to promote healthy lifestyles and physical activity and is supported by Oswestry Rugby Club. The costs involved in the event are for necessary equipment, promotion and the presence of a 'celebrity' strongman to judge and adjudicate.	£260	£260
A2	Shropshire Council Library Services Summer Reading Challenge Events	A contribution towards total project costs of £515 to hold three events to promote the Summer Reading Challenge. The aim of holding the events is to increase the number and diversity of the children signing up to the Reading Challenge and to encourage them and their families to become library users, as well, of course, to increase literacy levels and a love of reading.	£480	£480
A3	Oswestry Community Action Comics Stripped	A contribution towards total project costs of £3,366.70 to provide arts activities for young people and their families at The Qube. The programme will be 6 workshops, 2 three day courses and one story telling event, plus an exhibition over an eight week period. It is recommended that a grant of £450 be made. It is felt that this is an ambitious high quality project, which could look for additional sources of funding if it is to be delivered as originally planned, including considering increasing the costs of the workshops for those who are able to afford to pay for them. It is recognised that the project may have to be scaled back if additional funding cannot be found, but this is a time of reduced LJC funding where difficult decisions have to be made and the widest possible benefit to the community sought.	£1,450	£450

The main costs are associated with the creation of the promotional guide, providing subsidised transport and organising activities as part of the weekend.</p> <p>It is recommended that a grant of £1,000 be made. It is also recommended that funding is sought from other LJCs where activity is planned.</p>	£3,406	£1000
A5	<p>RE:Play it/ Rachel Edwards</p> <p>Summer art workshops in Cae Glas Park</p>	<p>A contribution towards total project costs of £2,200 to run six creative workshops in Cae Glas park in 2011 and 2012 based on the use of recycled cardboard and Makedo. The workshops for young people will be linked to the national Playdays held at the beginning of August each year.</p> <p>It is recommended that a grant of £400 be made to enable the Makedo resources to be purchased.</p>	£1,200 (£2,200 over 2 years)	£400
A6	<p>Take 2 The Streets Oswestry Traders Group</p>	<p>A contribution towards total project costs of £2,575 to hold an Oswestry Traders Day on 30th July. The event will be run in association with Oswestry Chamber of Commerce & Industry. The main costs of the event are advertising it prior to the day and creating leaflets and maps for use on the day.</p> <p>It is recommended that a grant of £1,000 be made as it is hoped that the printing and design costs quoted could be reduced.</p>	£1,450	£1000
A7	<p>Jubilee Money Advice Service</p>	<p>A contribution towards total project costs of £14,049 to run a debt advice service in Oswestry, which complements the work of the CAB and is closely linked to Landlord Services. The service is run by volunteers but the service is looking for funding for the costs of renting suitable premises, training volunteers and office costs.</p> <p>It is recommended that a grant of £2,000 be made to cover the costs of running the Oswestry office. It is also recommended that an application is made to other LJCs where services are being delivered and the CAT continues to support JMAS with finding low cost alternative accommodation.</p>	£5,000	£2000

A8	Activities at Llwynfields Llwynfields Residents Association	A contribution towards total project costs of £383.39 to organise events for the residents of Llwynfields and purchase a set of Boccia Bowls and other games for residents to use.
