It was suggested that a litter bin should be provided which may be used if one is provided. In addition, it has been agreed that if Shifnal Town Council provide the bins, Shropshire Council will empty them. Litter picks are arranged for Mondays and Fridays. Persistent dog fouling should be reported to Shropshire Council on 0345 678 9006. Poop scoop bags can be obtained from Shifnal Library.
