Following guidance from the police, the hall would like to install CCTV equipment to try and prevent continued vandalism and provide sustainability for the hall and its users. B	Oswestry Heritage Forum – Funding towards heritage open days 2011 (Community & Tourism)	Heritage open days celebrate England's fantastic architecture and culture offering free access to properties that are usually closed to public or normally charge for admission. Following the success of last year's Oswestry Heritage Days the group are seeking support towards total costs of project which include leaflets, banners, transport and activity. The heritage open days pull together tourism attractions across the area and demonstrate a package for locals and visitors. C	Peel's Plantation – maintenance and felling at site (Community & Environment)	Although regular maintenance work has taken place over the years, a significant amount of thinning is now needed at Peel's Plantation. Advice from the professional forestry consultants, Small Woods Association and Shropshire Council agree that up to 30% of existing trees will need to be thinned. The major felling is beyond the standard maintenance carried out by the volunteers. The woodland is at the heart of the village and used extensively by locals of all ages. The festival also needs to provide a large marquee and trestle tables. For the benefit of visitors, tables and chairs will also be needed.
