Summary

This report details the most recent applications to the StrettonDale Local Joint Committee and provides an update on the projects awarded funding at the last meeting.

Recommendations

Report

1. StrettonDale Local Joint Committee has a delegated budget of £22,000, based on its electorate (4,679). In addition £3,015 was carried forward as underspend from 2009-10.
2. The Committee has approved applications to the value of £7,215 this year, and therefore has a current budget of £17,800.
3. The Constitution governing the Local Joint Committee states :
 - a. The LJC must use standard guidelines and application forms when granting funding to third parties
 - b. The LJC budgets will be subject to Shropshire Council's audit procedures.
3. All of the projects seeking funding at this meeting have been assessed against criteria and are considered eligible for approval.
