The Five Perry Parishes LJC Application Form Summaries

Summary

This report provides information on the Five Perry Parishes LJC Application Forms. The Five Perry Parishes include:

- Whittington
- Baschurch
- West Felton
- Ruyton-XI-Towns
- Hordley

Recommendations

- That the four applications received are awarded funds to support their activities.

Report

1. From 1 April 2009 Shropshire Council has created 28 Local Joint Committees to operate across the whole county. These LJCs are legally constituted decision making committees of Shropshire Council.
2. The LJC is responsible for awarding and expenditure of the devolved budget. A budget of £28,000 has been made available to the Five Perry Parishes LJC. Expenditure against this budget is agreed by the Committee after consideration at planning meetings, decision reports then voting by Committee members. Voting is undertaken by the members of the Committee, all with equal votes, with decisions determined by a simple majority.
3. To avoid any last minute assessments of applications, the future deadline date for receipt of applications is as follows:
 - 27th November 2009 ready for the January LJC meeting.

Applications received prior to the planning meeting

4. The following five applications have been received and recommended to the LJC:
 - a) Baschurch Village Hall has requested £1,500 for the partial re-wiring of the Village Hall and the installation of anti-rodent measures. No quotes have been received to date
 - b) Ruyton-XI-Towns Parish Hall has requested £1,500 for the purchase and installation of new kitchen units, worktops and sinks and for further insulation and repairs to the Parish Hall
 - c) Baschurch Bowling Club have requested £1,500 for the improvement of storage facilities at Baschurch Bowling Club
 - d) West Felton Village Hall has requested £1,479 for the refurbishment and alterations at the Hall
 - e) Whittington Senior Citizens Club has requested £6,000 for the creation of six parking bays and 1 disabled parking bay from an area around the club owned by Shropshire Council.

5. The recommendation is that b) Ruyton X1 Town Parish Hall and c) Baschurch Bowling Club receive funds for the total amounts requested. For a) Baschurch Village Hall to be deferred until quotes are received, for d) West Felton Village Hall to receive £1,269 and e) Whittington Senior Citizens Club to receive £1,500.
