The service will depart from Hubert Way at 0942 & 1142 for travel to Shrewsbury town centre. Services will then return from the bus station at 1207 & 1407. This will enable passengers who are unable to walk to Ellesmere Road with a service from the estate. This service is operated commercially by Bryn Melyn with no subsidy from Shropshire Council. Details of the full timetable will be available shortly.</p> |
