Summary

This report considers the devolved funding allocated to the Five Perry Parishes Local Joint Committee (LJC) for 2010/11.

Recommendations

- A.** It is recommended that the Five Perry Parishes Local Joint Committee allocate funding for the following amounts to the following organisations and their projects:

1. Since 1 April 2009 there have been 28 Local Joint Committees to operate across the county. These LJC's are legally constituted decision making committees of Shropshire Council. A total of £28,000 has been devolved to this committee to fund projects in the local community served by the LJC.
