Current consultations include the following:

### **(a) Transforming Social Care**

The aim of the consultation is to:

- To make the social care system more person centred, consistent and equitable
- To offer people a much greater say in how they get support.
- To support people to maximise their independence for longer
- To ensure people have access to good information and support
- To strengthen communities to include and support vulnerable, disabled and frail people
- To implement 'Putting People First' (DH 2007)

The end of the consultation period is 31<sup>st</sup> March 2011.

### **(b) Healthy Connections Membership Scheme**

The aim of the scheme is to develop two-way communication links between the PCT and the public and to help provide Shropshire people with healthy living and public health advice and support.

The end of the consultation period is 30<sup>th</sup> March 2012
