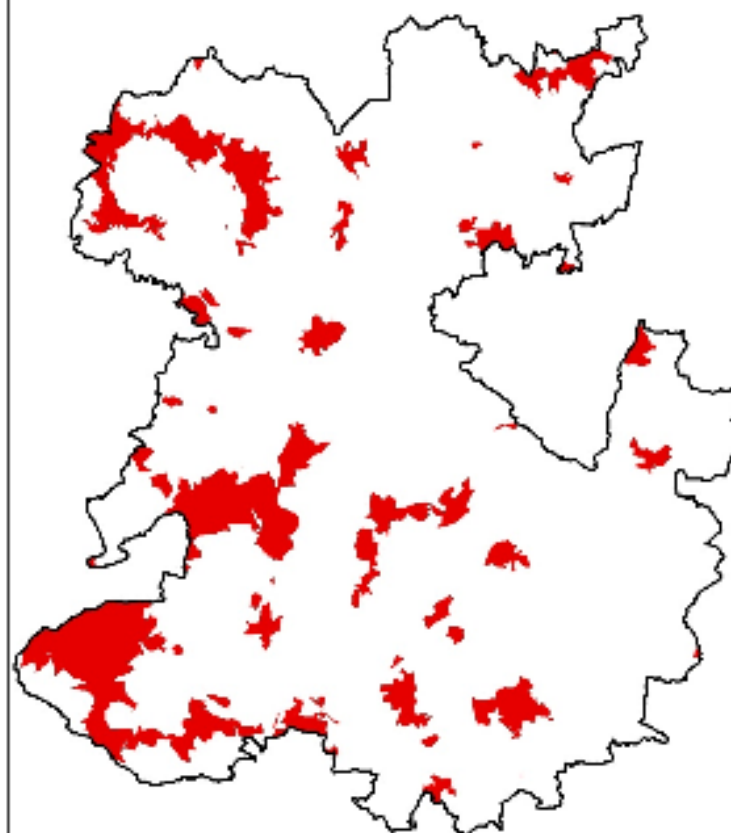


Why broadband is important?

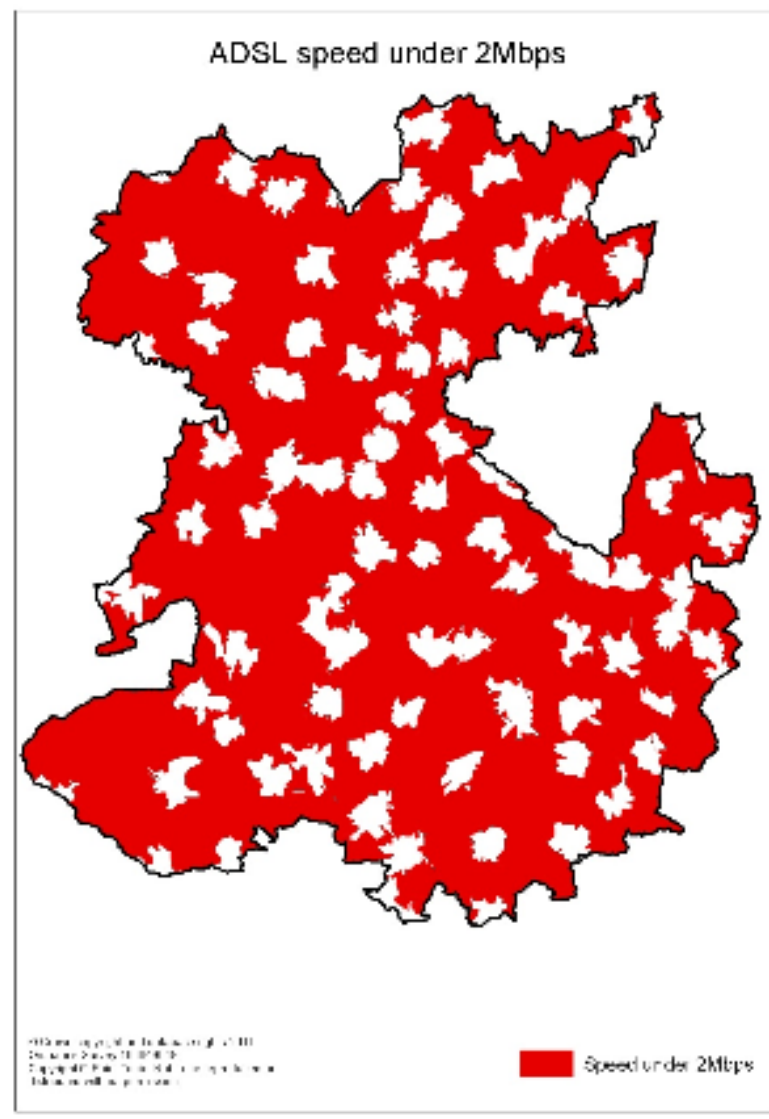


ADSL Not-Spots 0Mbps


ADSL Not-Spots 0Mbps




What has been done?

- Mapped current broadband in Shropshire
 - Submitted a bid to BDUK – awarded £8.2 million with Telford and Wrekin
 - Capital Funding agreed - £2 million
- 

What do we want to achieve?

- Enable 100% of Shropshire access to a minimum of 2mbps
 - Deliver superfast broadband to as much of the county as possible
 - Future proof broadband – mobile
