The new boiler will give savings on running costs and improve safety because the existing boiler is pumping out fumes into the Hall. Installing a combi boiler, will in turn provide further savings because it will heat hot water on demand. A new boiler will also enhance the new kitchen facilities which are being installed. Recommendation that funding is held until end of January 2012, whilst Ash Village Hall completes urgent work on the roof, before the new boiler is installed. The North Shropshire Grasstrack Car Club wish to resurface the race track and upgrade of safety catch (flying debris) fencing for enhanced safety in the viewing area. Flying debris from the track surface makes the race track unsafe and has put visiting groups off for safety reasons (a local group of adults with learning disabilities could not race after a risk assessment was carried out and the track was deemed not safe for them, this in turn lead to disappointment for the group). They would like to purchase 6 x 2-3 man tents, a patrol tent, 2 x cast iron cooking rings, 10 x compasses, stackable tables and chairs and 10 x wooden mallets.
