Mr R Hewson,	D Gradwell/ PC Karen Evans	<p>Highways officers report that they had carried out informal consultations with the local Members, Whitchurch Town Council etc., regarding the installation of bollards on Pepper Street (see map of plan changes on display at the meeting). No objections had been received to the informal proposal and therefore it was assumed that there was general support for the introduction of bollards on Pepper Street.</p> <p>The statutory consultation period is 3 weeks. Assuming there are no objections, the detailed design can be finalised and the scheme would look to be implemented in the early part of the next financial year; April 2013. However if any objections are received to the proposals, this could delay the process and it may be necessary to do a decision report to the North Area Planning Committee.</p>
