Officer clarifications:

<u>Consultations</u>: It is reaffirmed that there have been no substantive amendments to the proposals since the application was first considered by the committee which would necessitate a full re-consultation. The only issues which have been progressed in the meantime have been with respect to detailed ecological issues and relevant Ecological consultees have been consulted on these matters.

<u>The AONB Partnership</u> objected to the application as submitted on the basis of potential adverse impacts on ecological interests in the River Clun catchment. These matters are addressed by the ecological mitigation package referred to in the main report which would be delivered by means of a legal agreement. A previous holding objection by Natural England has been withdrawn. Hence, this issue has been addressed.

<u>SC Ecology</u>: Paragraph 6.10 of the main report relates to the previous position of SC Ecology prior to withdrawal of Natural England's holding objection. The final sentence of the paragraph should now be disregarded as Natural England has been consulted and has responded on the Appropriate Assessment. SC Ecology have not objected to the proposals.

<u>SC Conservation</u> originally advised on the need for photomontages and detailed plans. Officers consider that these matters are fully addressed in the applicant's Heritage Statement and LVIA.

<u>Habitat Risk Assessment</u>: The HRA attached to the report is the original HRA which was produced before Natural England withdrew its objection. NE was subsequently consulted on an updated HRA incorporating an Appropriate Assessment and has withdrawn its objection as detailed in Section 6.3b of the main report.
