1	Election of Chair It was proposed, seconded and duly resolved that Jean Jones be elected Chair of the Broseley and Barrow Local Joint Committee for the forthcoming Municipal Year.	
2	Welcome and Introductions The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting.	
3	Appointment of Vice-Chair It was proposed seconded and duly resolved that David Turner be appointed vice chair of the Broseley and Barrow LJC for the forthcoming municipal year	
4	Apologies for Absence and Substitutions Apologies from Andrew Cooke who was going to be late and arrived at 7.30 p.m.	
5	Declarations of Interest There were no declarations of interest.	
6	Notes of the Last Meeting <u>RESOLVED</u> : That the notes of the meeting held on 4 February 2014 be approved and signed by the Chair as a correct record.	

7	<p>Current Policing Issues – PACT (Partners and Communities Together)</p> <p>CSO Mal Goddard said there had been an increase in shed/outbuilding burglaries and the message was not to keep valuables in these buildings if you don't have to. Also, if you do have valuables, it is always a good idea to take a note of any serial numbers and photograph the items.</p>	
8	<p>Ben Walker, Superfast Broadband</p> <p>Ben Walker gave an update on the Superfast Broadband Programme. (A copy of this presentation is available on request).</p> <p>Ben added that even with Superfast Broadband it depends how far away you are from the exchange you are as to whether it will make any difference.</p> <p>You should contact your internet provider to update your package.</p> <p>People can visit the website: http://connectingshropshire.co.uk/when-and-where/ to check which exchange area and cabinet serves their premises and to check the availability of fibre broadband.</p>	
9	<p>Kate Garner, Local Commissioning</p> <p>Kate Garner gave a presentation on Locality Commissioning. (A copy of this presentation is available on request).</p> <p>She said that the LJC's would be given more autonomy and as things are continually evolving, they are likely to be given more things to do with regard to commissioning services.</p> <p>Someone asked if the meetings would continue to be in public and the answer was that it is up to the Committee. They have to meet twice a year in public as it states this in the constitution.</p> <p>Some concern was expressed as to where the resources would come from in order to deliver these services.</p>	
10	<p>Ian Kilby – Planning Enforcement</p> <p>Ian Kilby gave a presentation on Planning Enforcement. (A copy of this presentation is available on request).</p> <p>Some discussion also took place around the 5 year land supply. Ian said that at the end of July, the Sam Dev document will go to the Planning Inspector.</p> <p>Jean Jones thanked Ben, Kate and Ian for their presentations.</p>	

11	<p>Public Question Time /Identification of future agenda items</p> <p>It was suggested that a future agenda item could be around Planning in the Conservation Area.</p> <p>Problems with on-street drinking at the weekend was discussed and it was agreed that this would be passed to Bronze Level Tasking.</p> <p>Concern at the speed of traffic at Benthall Bank was also expressed and Barrow Parish Council are looking into this matter.</p> <p>The Committee expressed their thanks to Willey Hall volunteers for the refreshments.</p> <p>Date of Next Meeting</p> <p>The meeting noted that the date of the next meeting of the Broseley and Barrow Local Joint Committee would be held on 4th February 2015 at Victoria Hall, Broseley.</p>
