5	Current Policing Issues – PACT (Partners and Communities Together) CSO Mal Goddard gave an update on local crime. Inconsiderate parking continues to be an issue. Parking on pavements is being monitored.

7	Broseley Library and Asset Transfer Cllr Ian Pickles of Broseley Town Council gave an update. Questions from the public: Where is the money coming from to pay library staff wages? This is accounted for in the Service Level Agreement What happens after 3 years? If the library is withdrawn, the Town Council will have to decide what to do with the space but it would be for community use. Why is it a 125 year lease? Although it is a 125 year lease, there is facility within the agreement to end it before the term. What if there is damage to the building? Shropshire Council will be handing it over in a good state of repair, then the Town Council will be responsible. They will be insured against damage.

Only 2% increase in precept which can only be spent on adult social care
