7 Current Policing Issues – Partners and Communities Together (PACT)

Areas of concern:

HGVs – Barrow Street – DT said that Much Wenlock, Broseley and Barrow Councils are working together with Highways.

DT said that there is ongoing work in Sheinton Street with regard to HGVs and the installation of signal detection. He will report back to the next LJC.

Parking – the police rely on civil enforcement. Steve Brown of Shropshire Council said that he will advise Fulcrum – civil enforcement, to patrol Much Wenlock.

SB

Sheinton St – speeding - PC Cowan explained about when and where speed enforcement can take place. Community speedwatch is something she is going to investigate further. The CSO's are also going on laser gun courses in September.

JC

A resident raised concerns about speeding surveys that were carried out by the Safety partnership. PC Cowan said she will liaise with the partnership and ask them to re-do them if necessary.

YH raised concerns about faded yellow lines by bus shelter. SB will investigate.

PC Cowan said there had been a few issues with ASB and 12 letters

have been sent to parents asking for their cooperation.

8 Highways Issues

Steve Brown, Highways Transport and Environmental Maintenance Manager gave an overview of his role at Shropshire Council and invited members of the public to ask questions.

Issues raised

Civil enforcement – this is the responsibility of Fulcrum. SB will advise.

Cutting of grassed areas to allow for growth of wild flowers – Highways do liaise with the relevant team and take advice.

Overgrown trees/hedges – John Yeates

Old police station/Sheinton St – worn surface

Shipton Link Rd – carriageway resurfacing – standing water damage
