- 5.1. Collective Voices workshop on 26/06/17 looked at the amalgamation of MiR / P2P boards. Workshop involved participants from a range of partnership boards including social care, health and children's services. Workshop showed strengths of partnership working but also highlighted opportunities for more effective ways of working, innovation and placing lived experience at the heart of services.
- 5.2. Initial scoping of partnership boards and Peer review experience illustrated partnerships not always transparent and working jointly.
- 5.3. Local Account uses real life stories to illustrate the work of ASC throughout the previous year. The Local Account is an opportunity to air 'difficult conversations' going on as well as achievements.
