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## 1.0 Summary

1.1 This report includes a draft terms of reference and outline work programme for the Area Committees Task and Finish Group.

## 2.0 Recommendations

2.1 Agree the draft terms of reference and work programme, subject to any amendments that the committee agrees.

# 3.0 Opportunities and risks

- 3.1 This review provides the opportunity to scrutinise a new way of organising local committees, aligned geographically with place planning boundaries. It will also provide the opportunity to devise and appraise future roles for these groups.
- 3.2 A failure to review arrangements for local committees could result in declining opportunities for towns and parishes to work together to make best use of local funding.

#### 4.0 Financial assessment

4.1 There are no financial considerations to this report. Any recommendations that are made to Cabinet will need to carry a full financial assessment.

# 5.0 Report

- 5.1 In late 2017 the Communities Overview Committee agreed to set up a task and finish group to look at the role of local Joint Councils in current council arrangements. It held two two-day workshops in April 2018 and concluded that:
  - There is an opportunity for a new model of joint local meetings to be aligned with the purpose and boundaries of the Place Plan areas.
  - There is an opportunity to pick up the feedback from the recent council
    Peer Challenge Review and respond to a recommendation to strengthen
    the relationship between Shropshire Council and local councils.

Meeting, date: Report heading

- The future resource and role of the Community Enablement Team needs to be confirmed to inform the design and delivery of any future model.
- There is an opportunity for pooling financial resources within an area, e.g. individual small grant pots.
- There is an opportunity for co-ordinating and using the resources of an area, e.g. the corporate social responsibility of businesses, voluntary activity, and social action to get things done locally.
- 5.2 At its meeting on 21 May 2018 it agreed to set up a new task and finish group, to draft possible new arrangements for local committees, based on place planning boundaries.
- 5.3 A draft terms of reference for this task and finish group is attached as appendix 1.
